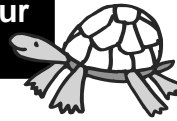

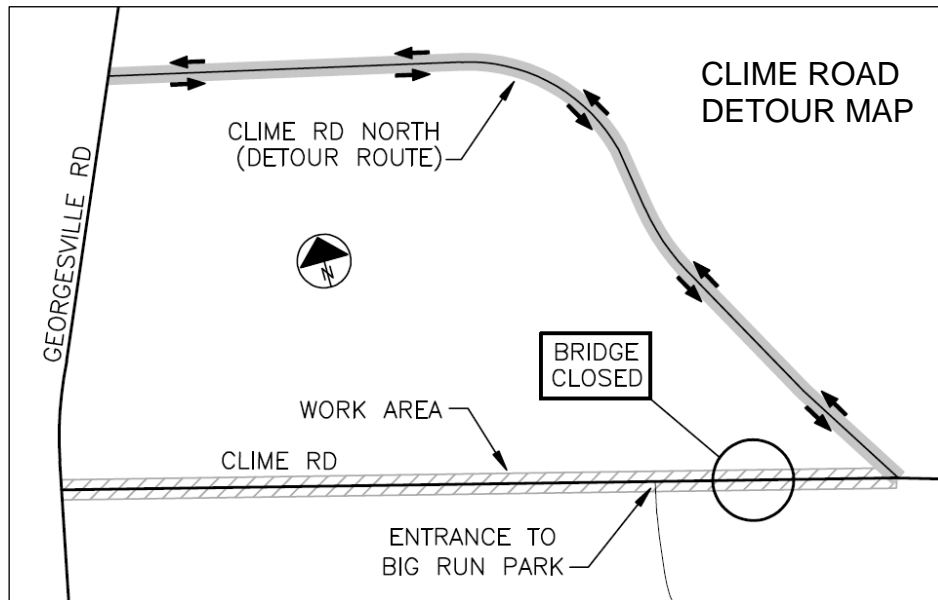
Please go slow around our construction zone!



Dear Neighbor,

The widening and reconstruction of Clime Road, including the replacement of the bridge over Big Run, will require the roadway between Georgesville Road and Clime Road North to be closed to through traffic on or about August 3 until early November 2010, weather permitting.

The detour route for westbound motorists will follow Clime Road North north to Georgesville Road, and south to Clime Road. Eastbound motorists will follow the detour route in the opposite direction. **Local access to businesses and Big Run Park, from the west, will be maintained.**



This work is part of the over-all improvement of Clime Road, from Georgesville Road to Demorest Road, which will occur during the 2011 and 2012 construction seasons. The project involves the widening and reconstruction of the roadway to accommodate east and westbound lanes, a center turn lane, and two bike lanes; construction of storm sewers, curbing, gutters,



driveway aprons, and sidewalks; and the installation of new street lighting, traffic signals and signage.

Demorest Road will also be widened and rebuilt, from Bonnie Court to Franklin Heights High School, to accommodate

north and southbound lanes, a center turn lane, and right turn lane on the north leg of the Clime Road intersection.

The Franklin County Engineer's Office will supervise the building of this \$11.9 million project by the Kenmore Construction Company. Funding will be provided by the Federal Highway Administration, through the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission, and the Ohio Public Works Commission.

The widening and reconstruction Clime Road and Demorest Road is scheduled for completion in the fall of 2012.

The current \$8 million project to widen and rebuild Clime Road east of Demorest Road, between Talbot Place and Harrisburg Pike (U.S. Rt. 62), which began in February 2009, will be completed this summer, weather permitting. East and westbound motorists are now driving on newly built pavement.

Thank you for your patience and understanding of our efforts to improve traffic safety and mobility on Clime and Demorest Roads.
