Dear Neighbor,

Replacement of the West Main Street Bridge, spanning Alum Creek east of Cleveland Avenue, will require the roadway to be closed to all traffic on or about July 12 until August 2011, weather permitting.

The posted detour route for eastbound motorists will follow Cleveland Avenue north to County Line Road, east to West Street and south to West Main Street. Westbound motorists will the detour in the opposite direction.

The Franklin County Engineer's Office will supervise the building of this \$5.8 million project by the Kokosing Construction Company. Funding will be provided by Franklin County and the City of Westerville.

The project involves the demolition of the current bridge, built in 1969, and the construction of a new triple-span, reinforced concrete, haunched box-girder structure. Architectural enhancements include decorative railing and street lighting.
