To vacate the first alley east of Parkview Avenue from Main Street north to the south line of Lot 3 of Powell's Subdivision, being approximately 323 feet.

Whereas, the owners of all the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said alley have petitioned Council praying that said alley be vacated; and

Whereas, Council is satisfied there is good cause for said vacation as prayed for and such vacation will not be detrimental to the public interest, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the first alley east of Parkview Avenue from Main Street north to the south line of Lot 3 of Powell's Subdivision, being approximately 323 feet, be and the same is hereby vacated, reserving, however, to the City and public and quasi-public corporations now or hereafter holding franchises and permits from the city of the supplying of water, gas, electricity and telephone service, all necessary easements in, under or over said alley, for the purpose of sewers, mains, poles, wires and conduits, and maintaining and keeping them in repair, so far as the city may deem it to be necessary, to supply its inhabitants with public utility service, sewers and drains.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
