

An ordinance No. 319.

To vacate the first alley south of Main Street from Roche Avenue to Center Avenue, and also the alley between Center Avenue and Roche Avenue from Mound Street to the first alley south of Main Street.

Whereas, the council of the Village of Bexley is of the opinion that there is good cause for vacating that part of the allies aforesaid and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interests; and

Whereas, the written consent of the property owners abutting upon that part of said allies proposed to be vacated has been filed with the council.

Now Therefore, be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the first alley south of Main Street in said village, from Roche Avenue to Center Avenue and also the alley between Center Avenue and Roche Avenue from Mound Street to the aforesaid first alley south of Main Street, be and the same hereby are vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
