

ANN ORDINANCE NO. 589.

To change the name of certain streets and avenues in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

WHEREAS, petitions by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity thereof have been filed with council, praying that the names of the following streets be changed as follows, to-wit:

That York Avenue be changed to Astor Avenue; that Platte Avenue be changed to Clifton Avenue; that Bexley Drive be changed to Sheridan Avenue; that Bexley Avenue be changed to Bexford Place and that Hartley Road between Main Street and Broad Street be changed to Roosevelt Avenue, and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such changes of the names and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO

Section 1. That the name of York Avenue be changed to Astor Avenue; that the name of Platte Avenue be changed to Clifton; that the name of Bexley Drive be changed to Sheridan Avenue; that the name of Bexley Avenue be changed to Bexford Place and that the name of Hartley Road between Main Street and Broad Street be changed to Roosevelt Avenue.

Section 2. That this Ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
