

ORDINANCE NO. 624.

To change the name of certain streets and avenues in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

WHEREAS, petitions by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity have been with council, praying that the names of the following streets may be changed as follows, to-wit: that Belgard Lane be changed to Remington Road and that Roche Avenue be changed to Remington Road, and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for the change of names and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the name of Belgard Lane be, and the same is hereby, changed to Remington Road and that the name of Roche Avenue, be and the same is hereby, changed to Remington Road.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
