

ORDINANCE NO. 806.

To vacate a portion of Michael Street, and the street East of lots 3 and 6, of Wells Heirs Subdivision.

WHEREAS, on the 25th day of January, 1927, a petition by the owner of all the lots abutting on the streets sought to be vacated, was duly presented to Council, praying that said streets be vacated, and

WHEREAS, the owner of all the land abutting has signed the petition in which case the Statute does not require a notice by publication, and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following described portion of Michael Street be and the same hereby is vacated, to-wit:

A portion of Michael Street 60 feet wide, running parallel to Main Street, and being the first street South of Main Street, the portion hereby vacated being more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point in Michael Street which is approximately 145 feet East of Pleasant Ridge Avenue, and beginning at the East side of a 12 foot alley which is platted to run North from Michael Street, the portion of which alley South of Michael Street having been vacated by ordinance No. 809; running from said alley East along Michael Street to a 16 foot alley which extends from Main Street South to Mound Street, in which alley was recently constructed a large storm Sewer, it being the first alley West of Enclaire Avenue.

Section 2. That the following described streets be and the same hereby is vacated, to-wit:

The street abutting and adjoining the West side of the last described 16 foot alley, and (platted 34 feet wide) running from Main Street South to Mound Street. It has been given no name. The part hereby vacated is all the ground lying West of the East line of Half Section 20 and East of the East line of lots 3 and 6, of Wells Heirs Subdivision.

Section 3. That this Ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
