

ORDINANCE NO. 840.

To vacate a street running South from Michael Street and being the street between lots 4 and 5, of Wells Heirs Sub-division.

WHEREAS, on the 1st day of March, 1927, a petition by the owner of all the lots abutting on the street sought to be vacated, was duly presented to council, praying that said street be vacated, and

WHEREAS, the owner of all the land abutting has signed the petition in which case the Statute does not require a notice by publication, and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the following described street be and the same hereby is vacated, to-wit:

Being in the Village of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio, and being an unnamed street 30 feet wide, shown in Plat of Well's Heirs Subdivision, Plat Book 2, page 280, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, as running from Michael Street South to Mound Street between lots 4 and 5, of said Well's Heirs Subdivision, it being the only street between Pleasant Ridge and Euclaire, running parallel to them.

Section 2. That this Ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

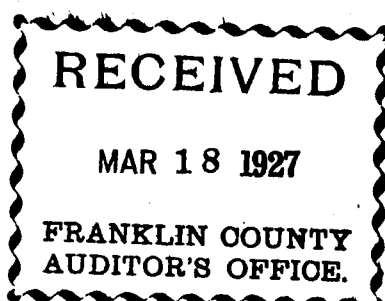
