CANAL WINCHESTER, OHIO, Oct 21 1922

Ordinance No. 204.

Whereas, a petition signed by various owners of lots abutting, owned or in the immediate vicinity of the Middle Alley hereinafter described has been presented to the Council praying for the vacation of certain portions of the same, and, Whereas, notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given by publishing the same in the Winchester Times, a newspaper of general circulation in the Corporation for six (6) consecutive weeks ending on the 18th day of November, 1893, and, Whereas, the Council is satisfied this is good cause for such vacation, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and that the same should be made; therefore, Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Canal Winchester, Ohio, that ten (10) feet off the east side of said Middle Alley south of Columbus Street and sixty five (65) feet off the south end of said Middle Alley be, and the same is hereby vacated.
