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CANAL WINCHESTER, OHIO, April 17 1902

Ordinance No. 234.

Whereas, a petition by various owners of lots abutting on, or in the immediate vicinity of the alley hereinafter described, has been presented to the Council, praying for the vacation of the same, and, Whereas, notice of the pending and prayer of said petition has been given by the publishing of the same in the Winchester Times, a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation for six consecutive weeks, ending on the 3rd day of October 1901; and, Whereas, the Council is satisfied there is good cause and reason for vacation; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and that the same should be made, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Canal Winchester Franklin County, Ohio:

That a portion of Center Alley from the south line of West Street to a point 175 feet south in said alley and opposite the partition line between the lots owned by John W. Shook and the lots of Sarah Bott, be, and the same is hereby vacated.
