

CANAL WINCHESTER, OHIO, July 16 1931

Ordinance No. 271.

Accepting a certain deed therein mentioned.
Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Canal Winchester,
State of Ohio:—

Section 1: That the deed of John King and Carrie King,
his wife, dated October 22nd, 1907, conveying to the Village
of Canal Winchester, Ohio, .024 of an acre of land off of the north
East corner of Lot No. 7 in Reuben Dore's addition to said village,
and more fully described by meter and bounds in said deed, to,
and the same is hereby accepted, and that the land so conveyed,
and the same is hereby declared a public highway.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force
from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
