Record of Ordinances

Ordinance No. 348

passed Oct, 6th, 1919.

Designating and naming as "Waterloo Street" the thoroughfare therein described.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Canal Winchester, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the following described thoroughfare within the corporate limits of the Village of Canal Winchester, State of Ohio, be and the same is hereby designated and named "Waterloo Street," to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the Columbus and Canal Winchester Pike and the westerly corporation line of said village, thence following the course of said Columbus and Canal Winchester Pike eastwardly to High street, and thence following the course of the thoroughfare heretofore known as Waterloo street eastwardly to the east corporation line of said village.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
