Ordinance No. 363.

Vacating Alley

Whereas, a petition signed by the owners of all abutting property and requesting the vacating of the alley herein after described, has been regularly filed by the clerk.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Canal Winchester, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the alley beginning at a point in the boundary line between the lands owned by Charles Dunlap and the lands owned by the said Board of Education, and extending thence in an easterly direction for the distance of 252 feet through the lands of the said Board of Education and thence to terminate, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
