

ORDINANCE NO. 450

An Ordinance of the Village of Winchester, also known as Canal Winchester, Franklin County, abandoning certain real estate in said Village.

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Winchester, also known as Canal Winchester, Franklin County, Ohio, is informed and believes that certain real estate located therein and more particularly described hereinbelow is owned by said Village, to be used by it for street and alley purposes; and

WHEREAS said real estate is not now and, so far as it knows, never has been used for street and alley or any other purposes by said Village; and

WHEREAS said Council wishes to abandon the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Winchester, also known as Canal Winchester, Franklin County, Ohio:

Section 1: That certain real estate, described as follows:

Situated in the Village of Canal Winchester, County of Franklin, State of Ohio, and further described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe in the south line of Long Alley (12') and at the north west corner of Lot #6 in Dove's Addition to the Village of Canal Winchester, Ohio, as the same is shown of record in Plat Book 3, page 174, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio; thence West along the south line of Long Alley 21.4 feet to the center of a high tension pole in the east line of Middle Alley; thence in a southerly direction along the east line of said Middle Alley 79.2 feet to a notch chiseled in a concrete driveway; thence northerly (the acute angle being 15°-20') along the west line of said Lot 6, 77.3 feet to the place of beginning.

now owned by said Village, and originally given or dedicated to it for street purposes, is not now and never has been used by said Village for such purposes or any other purposes and is not necessary for use as a part of any street or alley in said Village.

Section 2: That said real estate described hereinabove be, and the same hereby is, abandoned by said Village for street,

alley, or any other purposes, and said Village does hereby relinquish any and all claims which it may have thereto.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period provided by law.
