Ordinance No. 497

Accepting application for annexation of territory.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Winchester, also known as Canal Winchester, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the application of Mary B. Morehead Lane, et al., for the annexation of the following described territory in the County of Fairfield and adjacent to said Village of Winchester, also known as Canal Winchester, to-wit:

Situated in the Township of Violet, County of Fairfield and in the State of Ohio, known and distinguished as being a part of the southwest quarter of Section No. 29, Township No. 15, Range No. 20, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the county line and is nine (9) feet south of a state survey marker and by deed call record combined with measurement said beginning point 27.14 chains south of the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of said section 29; thence south 72° 03' east 172 feet to a stake; a state marker is 9 feet north; thence south 79° 56' east 136.6 feet to an iron pin in the gateway and a state marker is 13.67 feet north; thence south 2° 12' west 288.6 feet to the county line, an iron pin is on line 17 feet eastward; thence with the county line north 367.7 feet to the place of beginning. Containing 1.538 acres more or less.

Situated in the Township of Violet, County of Fairfield and in the State of Ohio, and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the southerly line of the Ohio Canal property and the County line between Fairfield and Franklin Counties, being opposite Station 1865-402 on the transit line of W. J. Slavin's survey of said canal and running thence southeasterly with the south line of said canal property 172 feet; thence continuing southeasterly with said south line 136.6 feet to the easterly line of a tract of land purchased by Mary B. Moreland Lane; thence northerly with said easterly line produced, 77 feet, more or less to the southerly line of a lease granted to the Scioto Valley Traction Company under date of December 28, 1916; thence northwesterly with the south line of said lease 305 feet, more or less, to the County line, thence southerly with said County line 65 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning. Reference, Plat No. 148 W. J. Slavin's survey, on file in the Department of Public Works, Columbus, Ohio, an accurate map of which territory, together with the Petition for its annexation and other papers relating thereto, and a certified transcript of the proceedings before the County Commissioners of Fairfield County in relation thereto are on file with the Clerk of said Village, be and the same is hereby accepted; and said territory is hereby annexed to said Village.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period provided by law.
