

ORDINANCE NO. 634

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT PORTION OF THE FIRST ALLEY WEST OF HIGHLAND AVENUE AND NORTH OF THE FIRST ALLEY NORTH OF FAIRFIELD STREET TO THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF LOMBARDY HEIGHTS.

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of September, 1959, a petition by Helen I. Conrad and Marvin K. Conrad, they being all the persons owning property abutting on the first alley west of Highland Avenue and north of the first alley north of Fairfield Street to the northern boundary of Lombardy Heights, in the Village of Canal Winchester, Ohio, was duly presented to Council, petitioning that said alley, between the points above named be vacated, and,

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as petitioned for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now, therefore,

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Canal Winchester, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That that portion of the first alley west of Highland Avenue and north of the northerly line of the first alley lying north of Fairfield Street to the northern boundary of Lombardy Heights be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
