ORDINANCE NO. 862

NARROWING LIBERTY STREET AND TO
DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of Council that im-
provements on lots in David Dixon's First Addition to Winchester,
which lots abut on Liberty Street, are actually encroaching onto
the street right of way of Liberty Street, and

WHEREAS, it appears that such encroachments have existed for
many years and that it was common belief of residents of the Village
that Liberty Street was less than sixty feet (60') in width; and

WHEREAS, the above described condition seriously impairs the
marketability of the real estate abutting Liberty Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village
of Canal Winchester, that:

Section 1: This Council is satisfied that the good cause
exists for narrowing Liberty Street from West Street, now known as
Columbus Street, northward to the Ohio Canal and that it will not
be detrimental to the general interests and that such narrowing
should be made.

Section 2: This Council hereby declares that Liberty Street
from West Street, now Columbus Street northward to the Ohio Canal
right of way be and the same is hereby narrowed to a width of 25 Feet,
along both sides of its present center line.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public health, safety and welfare of said Village.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and immediately after its passage.
