ORDINANCE NO. 869

TO ACCEPT THE DEDICATION OF A STREET 60 FEET IN WIDTH AND 1200 FEET IN LENGTH BY PAUL ARNOLD AND LLOYD STEBELTON TO PUBLIC USE *and to Yelder's emergency*

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Canal Winchester, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: That the deed of dedication by Paul Arnold and Lloyd Stebelton of a parcel of land described as follows:

Situate in the County of Franklin, State of Ohio, Village of Canal Winchester, being located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 25, Township 11, Range 21, Congress Lands, and being a strip of land sixty (60) feet in width out of the 42.36 acre tract conveyed to Paul Arnold and Lloyd E. Stebelton by deed of record in Deed Book 2888, Page 656, all references being to records of the Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the centerline of Gender Road and the easterly line of the said Northwest Quarter of Section 25, said point being located North 4° 14' East, 435.60 feet from the southeasterly corner of the said Northwest Quarter of Section 25, being also the southeasterly corner of the said 42.36 acre tract;

thence North 85° 45' West, (being parallel to and 435.60 feet Northerly from the southerly line of the said Quarter Section), 1200.0 feet to a point;

thence North 4° 14' East, 60.0 feet to a point;

thence South 85° 45' East, 1200.0 feet to a point in the centerline of the said Gender Road and the easterly line of the said Quarter Section;

thence along the said centerline, South 4° 14' West, 60.0 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1.653 acres, more or less.

dedicating the same to public use be and the same is hereby accepted and confirmed.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
