Sec. 2. That the said engineer or engineering firm shall conduct the work to the satisfaction of the Director of Public Service and the Chief Sewerage Engineer of the City of Columbus.

Sec. 3. That the fees to be paid such engineer or engineering firm for services rendered shall not exceed the rates prescribed by the Ohio Society of Professional Engineers.

Sec. 4. That the sum of \$11,000.00, be and it is hereby appropriated from Fund No. 6800, Sewerage Improvement Fund No. 1-65, Code No. 460 to pay the cost thereof (Project 710-34, 1968 C.I.P.).

Sec. 5. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure which shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.

ORD. No. 1186-68—To vacate West Engler Street, between specified limits, and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, petition, signed by the owner, Board of County Commissioners and Wesleyan University, of all lots and lands abutting upon West Engler Street, from Front Street to Wall Street, was duly presented to this Council, praying for and consenting to the vacation of said portion of street, and

Whereas, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for in said petition, that it will not be detrimental to the general interests and ought to be made, and

Whereas, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the Department of Public Service in that the vacation of the portion of the street is immediately necessary so as not to delay construction in the area, thereby preserving the public health, peace and safety; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus:

Section 1. That West Engler Street, extending from the east line of South Front Street to the west line of South Wall Street, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Sec. 2. That the City of Columbus reserves the right to operate and maintain any and all sewers, water lines and any other public utilities owned by the City, and that the right is reserved to operate and maintain any other public utilities, if any, now existing on or in said street hereby vacated, and shall have the right to enter thereon at any time for the purpose of replacing, operating and maintaining the same.

Sec. 3. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.

ORD. No. 1187-68—To appropriate permanent and construction easements in, over and through real estate in connection with the Cherry Bottom Road-S.R. 161 Waterline Project, and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, on the 29th day of July,

1968, Council of the City of Columbus adopted Resolution No. 174X-68; and, whereas, on the 9th days of September, 1968, Council of the City of Columbus adopted Resolution No. 186X-68, both such resolutions declaring the necessity and intent to appropriate the land hereinafter described, notice of the adoption of such resolutions has been served on the owner(s) of, or person(s) having an interest of record in such premises; and

Whereas, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the Department of Public Service, Division of Water, in that it is immediately necessary to appropriate permanent and construction easements in, over and through the hereinafter described parcels of real estate necessary in connection with the Cherry Bottom Road-S.R. 161 Waterline Project so that there will be no delay in the construction of said project for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus:

Section 1. That a permanent easement in, over and through the following described parcel of real estate be, and the same hereby is appropriated for the public purpose of the Cherry Bottom Road-S.R. 161 Waterline Project, pursuant to and in accordance with Chapter 909, Columbus City Codes, 1959, the Charter of the City of Columbus, and the Constitution and laws of the State of Ohio, to-wit:

Parcel No. 5

Situated in Blendon Township, Franklin County, State of Ohio, being a 1.948 acre tract of land conveyed to Jesse James Phillips and Vera A. Phillips by deed as recorded in Volume 2713, page 613, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio. The water line easement on said tract is more fully described as follows:

Permanent Easement

Being a strip of land 10 feet on the east side and on the west side to the centerline of Cherry Bottom Road of the following described line:

Beginning at a point in the east line of said 1.948 acre tract 57 feet from the southeast corner of said tract, said corner being in the center of Cherry Bottom Road, thence N 28°28'16" W 165 feet to an angle point, thence N 28°28'16" W 182 feet to the point of ending, said point being in the north line of said 1.948 acre tract.

Permanent Easement

Being a strip of land along the west side of said 36.733 acre tract and bounded on the south by the south line of said 36.733 acre tract, on the west by the centerline of Cherry Bottom Road, on the north by the north line of said 36.733 acre tract, and on the east by a line beginning at a point in the north line of 36.733 acre tract thence in a southerly direction 47.5 feet east of and parallel to the centerline of Cherry Bottom Road a distance of 55 feet, thence in a westerly direction perpendicular to the centerline of Cherry Bottom Road a distance of 3 feet, thence in a southerly direction 44.5 feet east of and parallel to the centerline of Cherry Bottom Road a distance of 58 feet, thence in an easterly direction perpendicular to the centerline of Cherry Bottom Road a distance of 3 feet, thence in a southerly direction 47.5 feet east of and parallel to the cen-

Parcel No. 16—Permanent Easement

Situated in Blendon Township, Franklin County, State of Ohio, being a 3.01 acre tract of land conveyed to Margaret G. Keenan by deed as recorded in Volume 1630, Page 332, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio. The water line easement on said tract is more fully described as follows:

Being a strip of land 20 feet wide, 10 feet on either side of a line, said line being described in two parts of the tract.

Strip 1

Beginning at a point in the east line of said 3.01 acre tract 57 feet south along the east property line from the northeast corner of said tract, thence N 69° 35' 07" W, 156.00 feet to the point of ending, said ending point being 167 feet from the northeast corner, along the north line of said 3.01 acre tract.

Construction Easement

Also, a construction easement to be used during the period of construction only and being an additional strip of land and adjoining same on the north side of the above described 20 foot strip of land. Said additional strip shall be that remaining parcel from the above described 20 foot strip of land to the north and east lines of said 3.01 acre tract.

Strip 2
