enth Avenue; and the first alley south of Seventh Avenue, extending from the west line of Fourth Street to the west terminus; subject to reservations provided herein for public utilities.

Whereas, petition, signed by the owners of all lots and lands abutting upon the first alley south of Seventh Avenue, between specified limits, was duly presented to this Council, praying for and consenting to the vacation of the alleys, between the points mentioned; and

Whereas, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for in said petition and that it will not be detrimental to the general interests and ought to be made; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus:

**Section 1.** That the First alley west of Fourth Street, extending from the south line of Seventh Avenue to the north line of the first alley south of Seventh Avenue; and the First alley south of seventh Avenue, extending from the west line of Fourth Street to the west terminus, be and the same are hereby vacated.

**Section 2.** That the City of Columbus reserves the right to operate and maintain any and all sewers, water lines, and any other public utilities owned by the City, and that the right is reserved to operate on or in said alleys hereby vacated, and shall have the right to enter thereon at any time for the purpose of constructing, installing, replacing, operating and maintaining the same.

**Section 3.** That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**ORD. No. 1195-77**—To accept the application for the annexation of certain territory containing 29.169± acres in Perry Township.

Whereas, a petition for the annexation of certain territory in Perry Township was duly filed by C. Robert Talbott; and

Whereas, the said petition was duly considered by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, April 20, 1977; and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners has approved the annexation of said territory to the City of Columbus as hereinafter described; and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners certified the transcript of the proceedings in connection with the said annexation with the map and petition required in connection therewith to the City Clerk who received the same on May 3, 1977; and

Whereas, sixty days from the date of said filing have now elapsed in accordance with the provisions of Section 709.04 of the Revised Code; and

Whereas, it is in the best interest of the City of Columbus to accept the annexation of the territory sought to be annexed by the aforesaid petition; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus:

**Section 1.** That the proposed annexation as applied for in the petition of C. Robert Talbott, being the majority owner of real estate in the territory sought to be annexed and filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, on January 31, 1977, in which said petitioners prayed for annexation to the City of Columbus, Ohio, of certain territory adjacent thereto as hereinafter described, and which said petition was approved for annexation to the City of Columbus by the Board of County Commissioners on April 20, 1977, be and the same is hereby accepted and said territory is hereby annexed to the City of Columbus. Said territory is described as follows:

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, Township of Perry, being part of Lot 36 in the First Quarter of Township 2, North, Range 19 West, United States Military Lands and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike set at the southeast corner of a 2.0 acre tract of land now or formerly owned by Ruth O. Baker, said railroad spike being South 12 degrees 23' East, a distance of 135.28 feet from a railroad spike found in the centerline of Smokey Row Road (60 feet wide) where it intersects the north line of Franklin County and South line of Delaware County.

Thence Southerly with the existing Columbus Corporation Line as established by said Columbus Ordinance No. 1996-74, and shown of record in Miscellaneous Volume 164, page 45, a distance of 441.77 feet to an angle point in an existing Columbus Corporation Line as established by Columbus Ordinance No. 370-72 and shown of record in Miscellaneous Volume 155, page 539, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio.

Thence Westerly along existing Columbus Corporation Line as established by said Columbus Ordinance No. 370-72, a distance of approximately 2,467.44 feet to a 1" O.D. iron pipe found at the northwest corner of the aforementioned Columbus Corporation Line.

Thence North 00 degrees 06' 14" West, a distance of 567.53 feet to a 1" iron rod found on the North line of Franklin County (South line of Delaware County).
