**ORD. No. 1483-80**—To levy a special assessment upon the lots and lands benefited by the improvement of Stambaugh Avenue, between specified limits.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus:

**Section 1.** That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Stambaugh Avenue, from Groveport Road to Elwood Avenue, by grading, draining, construction combined curb and gutter, Portland cement concrete foundation with asphaltic concrete leveling and surface courses, Portland cement concrete driveways, and doing such

other things as may be necessary, upon the lots and lands to be assessed in accordance with Ordinance No. 2065-78, passed October 30, 1978, in the City of Columbus, Franklin County, Ohio, has been prepared by the Division of Engineering and Construction, and the same is hereby confirmed, and that there be and hereby are levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter set forth, the several amounts as therein set forth, it being hereby determined and declared that each of said lots and lands is specially benefited by said improvement and in an amount equal to said improvement:
