

# ORDINANCES PASSED

**ORD. No. 1526-69**—To authorize the payment of \$15,000 to United Community Council from the Hare Charity Trust Fund. (\$15,000)

Whereas, the City of Columbus Youth Opportunity Program has had serious problems the last two (2) years in carrying out the City's summer inner-city employment program for 14 to 18 year olds, and

Whereas, the National Alliance of Businessmen in cooperation with the United Community Council has raised private funds to help finance this official city program, which provided that work be done for the City by youth who otherwise would be idle during the summer of 1969, and

Whereas, the United Community Council advanced an emergency loan of \$15,000 to help employ 500 youths last summer, and

Whereas, no formal contract existed between the City of Columbus and the National Alliance of Businessmen to provide services for the city, now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus:

Section 1. That the Trustees of the Hare Orphans Home, and City Council, in the exercise of its sound discretion, deems such an expenditure was incurred on behalf of the "benefit of the poor and unfortunate of said city" for a public purpose and in the public interest.

Sec. 2. That the Hare Charity Trust Fund Committee of Council finds that the Columbus Department of Youth Opportunity, with the cooperation of the National Alliance of Businessmen and United Community Council, provide \$45,000 in services to the City during the summer of 1969, \$30,000 of which was paid by private contributions leaving a deficit of \$15,000 which was advanced by the United Community Council to meet the payroll of 500 inner-city youth employed for city-wide clean-up and trash collection work.

Sec. 3. That for the purpose of reimbursing the United Community Council for the advance funds as provided in Section 2 hereof, there be and hereby is appropriated from the Hare Charity Trust Fund No. 312L, Major Code 440, the sum of \$15,000.

Sec. 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**ORD. No. 1527-69**—To vacate the alley north of Fifth Avenue, the second existing alley east of Nelson Road and the first existing alley east of Nelson Road, between specified limits.

Whereas, petition, signed by the owner of all lots and lands abutting upon the alley north of Fifth Avenue, the second existing alley east of Nelson Road, and the first existing alley east of Nelson Road, was duly presented to this Council, praying for and consenting to the vacation of said alleys, between specified limits, and

Whereas, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacations as prayed for in said petition, that they will not be detrimental to the general interests and ought to be made; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus:

Section 1. That the alley north of Fifth Avenue, extending from the first existing alley east of Nelson Road eastwardly to the west line of the second existing alley east of Nelson Road; second existing alley east of Nelson Road, extending from the south line of Ridgeway Avenue southwardly to the south line of the alley south of Ridgeway Avenue; first existing alley east of Nelson Road, extending from the south line of Ridgeway Avenue southwardly to the south line of the alley south of Ridgeway Avenue, be and the same are hereby vacated.

Sec. 2. That the City of Columbus reserves the right to operate and maintain any and all sewers, water lines and any other public utilities owned by the City, and that the right is reserved to operate and maintain any other public utilities, if any, now existing on or in said alleys hereby vacated and shall have the right to enter thereon at any time for the purpose of replacing, operating and maintaining the same.

Sec. 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**ORD. No. 1528-69**—To assess certain property owners for the cost of cutting weeds on vacant lots in the City of Columbus during the year 1969.

Whereas the Division of Parks and Forestry, Department of Public Service, during the year 1969 at their own expense, did mow the weeds on certain vacant lots in the City of Columbus, list attached, after proper notification of the property owners by the Service Director that such weeds must be mowed, and after failure of said property owners to mow said weeds, after a reasonable length of time after being so notified; and

Whereas Sections 2397.01 through 2397.05 of the Revised Code of the City of Columbus provide that upon receipt of a report from the Director of Public Service as to the cost thereof, to the City Council, and the approval thereof by City Council, the City Clerk shall make a return in writing to the Auditor of Franklin County of such charges, which shall be entered upon the tax duplicate of the County, all in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code, Section 731.54; now therefore

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus:

Section 1. That the report filed with the City Council by the Director of Public Service showing that the weeds had been mowed in 188 listed vacant lots at a total cost to the City of Columbus in the amount of \$3,796.00 be and is hereby approved.

Sec. 2. That the City Clerk shall make a return in writing to the Auditor of Franklin County of such charges, which shall be entered upon the tax duplicate of the County, as provided in Section 731.54 of the Revised Code of Ohio, and collected the same as are other taxes.

Sec. 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period provided by law.
