## COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

### Regular Meeting, Mon., May 11, 1931

Council met in regular session with President Worley in the chair. Roll call showed all members present.

County Auditor A. J. Thatcher submitted certification of sufficient funds in the general fund to pay certain appropriations. Placed on file.

W. H. Grey submitted complaint against amount of assessment for improvement of Pine street. Service.

C. H. Knowlton submitted a request for reconsideration of ordinance No. 554-30, providing for rezoning of certain property on West Broad street. Service.

The Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of the Latter Day Saints submitted a petition for the vacation of the first alley west of Twenty-second street north of Reinhard avenue. Service.

The Ladies' Auxiliary of the Postal Clerks submitted a request for extension of time until June 15, 1931, for display of automobile on High street. Safety.

F. E. Morrell submitted a request for gravel in alley north of Spring street between Eighteenth and Nineteenth streets. Service.

T. J. Moriarty submitted a request for cinders in rear of 429 East Lane avenue. Service.

The Linden Church Recreation League submitted a request that the Linden playgrounds be placed in good condition. Service.

Fred L. Rosemond submitted a communication commending council for the erection and maintenance of safety zones. Placed on file.

The Columbus Chamber of Commerce submitted a request that funds be provided for equipping the new Northmoor fire station. Safety.

adjustment in refusing him a permit to operate an auto wrecking plant at 181 East Fifth avenue. Service.

The South Side Civic and Industrial Association submitted a request for the improvement of High street, Hanford to Hosack. Service.

The West Side Board of Trade submitted copy of a resolution adopted requesting that a surety or cash bond be required of all drivers of taxicabs and automobiles kept for hire to cover the \$50 deductible clause of insurance policies. Safety.

## ORDINANCES PASSED

AN ORDINANCE No. 554-30—To change the zoning map attached to ordinance No. 38852, passed February 27, 1928, and as subsequently amended as herein provided.

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the zoning map attached to ordinance No. 38852, passed February 27, 1928, and as subsequently amended be and the same is hereby revised by changing the zoning of the property on the south side of West Broad street between the C. C. C. & St. L. R. R. and the west corporation line, extending south to the existing first industrial district, from a part B-1 and part C-1 business district to a part B-1 and part C-1 first industrial district, and the engineer of the planning commission be and he is hereby authorized and directed to make the said change on the said original zoning map in the office of the city clerk.

Sec. 2. That this ordinance shall

take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE No. 178-31—To change the names of certain streets.

Whereas, this council has considered the changing of certain street names because of duplications, continuities and confusion resulting from the terms "court" and "place", and

Whereas, it is the sense of this council that the names of the streets hereinafter designated should be changed; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the names of the streets hereinafter designated be and they are hereby changed as follows:

Aldrich road from Aldrich road to Henderson road, changed to Aldrich place;

Aldrich street from Lakeview avenue to Clinton Heights avenue, changed to Buekman avenue;

Aldrich avenue from the south line to the north line of Hayden's subdivision and from Chase avenue to the north line of Kessler's addition, changed to Loew street;

East Beechwood boulevard from High street to Indianola avenue, changed to Beechwood boulevard east;

South Beechwood road from High street to Olentangy boulevard, changed to Beaumont road;

Burwick avenue from Hudson street to Genesee avenue, changed to Bancroft street;

Brighton avenue from High street to Olentangy river, changed to Brighton road;

Brookwood north from Brookwood west to the east line of lots 1247 and 1248 of Berwick, changed to Medford place;

Brookwood west from Brookwood road to north terminus, changed to Brookwood place;

Chase avenue from St. Clair avenue to Mansfield street and from the alley east of Bassett street to Taylor avenue, changed to Gibbard avenue;

Clark avenue from the alley south of Twelfth avenue to Windsor avenue, changed to Louis avenue;

Clinton place from the west line of Clinton place subdivision to the Olentangy river, changed to Delhi avenue;

College street from the west line of Hayden place addition to Third street, changed to Sycamore street;

Dover avenue from Third avenue to south corporation line, changed to Delashmut avenue;
