WHEREAS, the plat titled VACATION OF A PORTION OF IMPORT STREET AND EASEMENTS AND DEDICATION OF A PORTION OF JOURNAL STREET, (hereinafter "Plat"), has been submitted to the City Engineer's Office for approval and acceptance; and

WHEREAS, OTR, AN OHIO GENERAL PARTNERSHIP, owner of the platted land, desires to dedicate to the public use all or such parts of the Street shown on said plat and not heretofore so dedicated; and

WHEREAS, after examination, it has been found to be in the best interest of the City to accept said Plat; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the Department of Public Service, Division of Engineering and Construction, in that it is immediately necessary to authorize the acceptance of this plat so that development of this area will not be delayed, thereby preserving the public health, peace, property, safety and welfare; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS:

Section 1. That the Plat titled VACATION OF A PORTION OF IMPORT STREET AND EASEMENTS AND DEDICATION OF A PORTION OF JOURNAL STREET, on file in the office of the City Engineer, Division of Engineering and Construction, be and the same hereby is accepted.

Section 2. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor or ten days after its passage if the Mayor neither approves nor vetoes the same.
