

**ORD. No. 211-82**—To dedicate a strip of land to be known as the relocated 20' alley north of West Broad Street, and, upon its construction to City specifications, to agree to vacate the existing 15' alley north of West Broad Street.

Whereas, City Council authorized this project in the context of Resolution No. 41X-81, Ordinance Nos. 664-81, 663-81 and 1357-81; and

Whereas, the next step in this process is to dedicate the alley which the City is receiving in exchange for the existing alley which Anthony-Thomas will request to have vacated in the near future; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus:

**Section 1.** That the following 20' wide piece of property be and the same is hereby dedicated to public use:

A 20' x 106.50' strip of land out of City owned land, as recorded in O.R. Volume 01144-G-18, said 20' strip to be used for alley purposes.

Being situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, City of Columbus and being a 20' strip of land off the entire north side of Lot #10 as shown on the plat of Franklin Subdivision #2, as recorded in Plat Book 4, Page 357, said 20' x 106.50' strip containing 0.049 acres, more or less.

**Section 2.** That upon completed construction of an alley built to City specifications on the piece of land described in Section 1, and upon approval of the City Engineer, the City shall vacate the first alley north of West Broad Street, from the east line of Yale Avenue to the west line of the alley east of Yale Avenue.

**Section 3.** That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
