

ORDINANCE.

of an alley in Martin & Stage's Fairwood addition, Columbus, O., and for an amendment of the ordinance.
 Passed December 1, 1873.)

and, to-wit: On the day of August 1873, was presented to the city council of Columbus, Ohio, a petition of the citizens thereof, praying for the vacation of a certain public alley, situated between lots 35 and 44, in Martin & Stage's subdivision of the Fairwood addition, as lies east of lots thirty-four, (44) in said subdivision, and contiguous to lots thirty-nine (39) and forty (40), and whereas, said petition was accompanied by a petition on the part of the petitioners to vacate the alley east of, and contiguous to said lot forty-four (44), in lieu of that as to which the petitioners have prayed, and whereas, due notice of this prayer and petition has been given, and no remonstrance has appeared against the same is not detrimental to the public interest, therefore,

Be it ordained by the City Council of the city of Columbus, Ohio, That so much of a certain public alley, as is described in the foregoing preamble described, as lies east of lots 35 and 44 in Martin & Stage's subdivision of the Fairwood addition to the city of Columbus, and also east of, and contiguous to lots 39 and 40, in said subdivision, be and the same is hereby declared vacated.
 Be it ordained by the City Council of the city of Columbus, Ohio, That B. F. Stage's amended plat of lots 1 to 26 of the Fairwood addition to the city of Columbus, as is shown on the west by lots 35 and 44, on the east by lots 39 and 40, on the south by the south line of Rich street, on the north by Town street; also lots A and B, and the same is hereby accepted by this ordinance, and the streets and alleys designated thereon be and the same is hereby declared public streets and alleys of the city of Columbus, Ohio.

AN ORDINANCE

Vacating a certain alley in Wm. Phelan's Mt. Pleasant addition.
 (Passed February 23, 1874.)

SECTION I. *Be it ordained by the City Council, That the alley between lots Nos. 5 and 11, in Phelan's Mt. Pleasant addition, running from Mt. Pleasant alley, to the alley in the rear of said lots 5 and 11, be, and the same is hereby vacated.* Alley vacated.

AN ORDINANCE

Vacating certain alleys therein named.
 (Passed October 19, 1874.)

SECTION I. *Be it ordained by the City Council of the city of Columbus, That the alley south of lots numbers 201, 202, 203, and the alley north of lots numbers 214, 215, and 216, of Sullivant's Western addition to the city of Columbus, be, and the same are hereby declared vacated.* Alleys vacated.

SEC. II. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage.

AN ORDINANCE

To vacate so much of the alley in the rear of lots 1, 2, 3 and part of lot No. 4, as lies between Woodruff avenue and the next alley north, in Tuller Bros.' addition.
 (Passed January 17, 1876.)

SECTION I. *Be it ordained by the City Council of the city of Columbus, That so much of the alley, in the rear of lots Nos. 1, 2, 3 and part of 4, as lies between Woodruff avenue and the first alley north, in Tuller Bros.' addition, be, and the same is hereby vacated as a public alley.* Alley vacated.

AN ORDINANCE

To vacate Lincoln street, between Kerr and Hamlet streets.
 (Passed January 17, 1876.)

SECTION I. *Be it ordained by the City Council, That so much of Lincoln street as lies between Kerr street and Hamlet street, be, and the same is hereby vacated as a public street.* Part of Lincoln street vacated.

AN ORDINANCE

To vacate so much of Loeffler avenue as lies between Friend and Rich streets.
 (Passed February 5, 1877.)

SECTION I. *Be it ordained by the City Council of the city of Columbus, That so much of Loeffler avenue as lies* Part of Loeffler avenue vacated.
