ORD. No. 2175-01 - To authorize and direct the Board of Health to enter into a lease agreement with the Central Ohio Transit Authority for clinic space for the Health Department's Perinatal Program, to authorize a total expenditure of \$33,804 from the Health Special Revenue Fund, and to declare an emergency. (\$33,804)

WHEREAS, the Columbus Health Department has a need for clinic space for the Perinatal Program; and,

WHEREAS, it is important that the Columbus Health Department's Perinatal Program and Children's Hospital clinics both be housed in the same facility; and,

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the Health Department in that it is immediately necessary to contract with the Central Ohio Transit Authority for the lease of clinic space for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, property, safety and welfare; Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS:

Section 1. That the Board of Health is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Central Ohio Transit Authority for the lease of 2,504 square feet of clinic space for the period of October 1, 2001 through September 30, 2002.

Section 2. That to pay the costs of said contract, the expenditure of \$33,804 is hereby authorized from the Health Special Revenue Fund, Fund No. 250, Department of Health, Department No. 50-01, Object Level One 03, Object Level Three 3301, OCA No. 502047.

Section 3. That the Heath Commissioner is hereby authorized to sublease a portion of the space to other health care providers.

That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, or ten days after passage if the Mayor neither approves nor vetoes the same.

\* ORD No. 2180-01 - To rename that the portion of East Third Avenue from Howard Street to Saint Clair to Saint Clair Avenue as Jerome H. Ross Avenue in recognition of Bishop Jerome H. Ross, Pastor of Triedstone Missionary Baptist Church for his 35 years of dedicated service to the Church community and to the City of Columbus; and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Service, Division of Engineering and Construction has received a request from members of the 35th Anniversary Committee of the Triedstone Missionary Baptist Church which is located at 858 East Third Avenue asking that the portion of East Third Avenue from Howard Street to Saint Clair Avenue be renamed Jerome H. Ross Avenue in recognition of Bishop Jerome H. Ross, Pastor of Triedstone Missionary Baptist Church for his 35 years of dedicated service to the Church community and the City of Columbus; and

WHEREAS, after investigation, it has been determined that there are no objections to the proposed renaming of this portion of East Third Avenue; and
