

Ordinances Passed

ORD. No. 2092-82—To authorize and direct the City Attorney to pay the settlement in a lawsuit filed in the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas, Case Number 81CV-05-2666, entitled **Jerrel Jewel v. Josef J. Sauter & City of Columbus**, and to appropriate Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$6,500.00) therefor. (\$6,500.00)

Whereas, on or about October 30, 1980, Jerrel Jewel was involved in an automobile accident with Josef J. Sauter, an employee of the Division of Sanitation, resulting in personal injuries to said Jerrel Jewel; and

Whereas, Jerrel Jewel filed a lawsuit in the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas against Josef J. Sauter and the City of Columbus in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00); and

Whereas, payment of this settlement to Jerrel Jewel in the amount of Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$6,500.00) would be in the best interest of the City; now, therefore, Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus:

Section 1. That the City Attorney is hereby authorized and directed to pay the settlement in the case of **Jerrel Jewel v. Josef J. Sauter and City of Columbus**, Case No. 81CV-05-2666, in the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas, in the amount of Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$6,500.00).

Section 2. That for the purpose of paying this settlement there be and is hereby appropriated from Fund No. 01-100, Department No. 60-02, Minor Code 531, Index Code 601013, the sum of Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$6,500.00).

Section 3. That the City Auditor be and hereby is authorized to draw his warrant upon the City Treasurer in the sum of Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$6,500.00) in payment of this settlement to Jerrel Jewel, and upon receipt of vouchers approved by the City Attorney and a release, properly executed by Jerrel Jewel, for all injuries and damages arising out of said incident, to pay and deliver the same to the said Jerrel Jewel.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

ORD. No. 2183-82—To amend the Capital Improvements Budget, Ordinance 538-82, as amended, by the establishment of seven projects; the amendment of three projects, including an increase in the I-670 Project of \$1,623,219.99 to reflect engineering services; and the deletion of four projects in various divisions.

Whereas, City Council has approved legislation authorizing the expenditure of \$1,623,219.99 for engineering services on the I-670 Project with the following ordinances: 940-82, 1152-82, 1832-82, 1833-82, 1834-82, 1951-82, 1996-82 and 1997-82; and

Whereas, three Sewerage and Drainage projects which were included in prior capital improvements budgets but excluded from the 1982 CIB, requires additional authority for the completion of the current phase of each; and

Whereas, surplus authority is available in the Blacklick Creek Sanitary Subtrunk Sewer Project for transfer to the Sewerage Projects; and

Whereas, the Division of Water has revised its capital plan to include three new projects by the postponement of four projects; Now, Therefore

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus:

Section 1. That Ordinance 538-82, as amended, be and the same is hereby amended to include the following projects:

ORD. No. 2185-82—To accept the application for the annexation of certain territory containing 1.225± acres in Blendon Township.

Whereas, a petition for the annexation of certain territory in Blendon Township was duly filed by Columbus Development Co. and

Whereas, the said petition was duly considered by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, and the annexation of said hereinafter described territory to the City of Columbus was approved by said Commissioners by vote dated August 30, 1982; and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners certified the transcript of the proceedings in connection with the annexation with the map and petition required in connection therewith to the City Clerk who received the same on September 13, 1982; and

Whereas, sixty days from the date of said filing have now elapsed in accordance with the provisions of Section 709.04 of the Revised Code; and

Whereas, it is in the best interest of the City of Columbus to accept the annexation of the territory sought to be annexed in the aforesaid petition; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus:

Section 1. That the proposed annexation applied for in the petition of Columbus Development Co., being the majority owner of real estate in the territory sought to be annexed and filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, on June 29, 1982, in which said petition was prayed for annexation to the City of Columbus,
