AN ORDINANCE No. 25502, To vacate River street, from the B. & O. S. W. R. R. to a point 15 feet west of the west line of lot No. 34 Geo. W. Sink's Subdivision; the alley north of River street, from the B. & O. S. W. R. R. to a point 15 feet west of the west line of lot No. 34 Geo. W. Sink's Subdivision; and the alley east of Loraine avenue, from River street to McKinley avenue.

Whereas, a petition has been presented to the Council of the City of Columbus, State of Ohio, praying for the vacation of River street, from the B. & O. S. W. R. R. to a point 15 feet west of the west line of lot No. 34 Geo. W. Sink's Subdivision; the alley north of River street, from the B. & O. S. W. R. R. to a point 15 feet west of the west line of lot No. 34 Geo. W. Sink's Subdivision; and the alley east of Loraine avenue, from River street to McKinley avenue; and,

Whereas, Notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law, by publication in The Columbus News, a newspaper published and of general circulation, in the corporation for six consecutive weeks ending November 10, 1910; and,

Whereas, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That River street, from the B. & O. S. W. R. R. to a point 15 feet west of the west line of lot No. 34 Geo. W. Sink's Subdivision; the alley north of River street, from the B. & O. S. W. R. R. to a point 15 feet west of the west line of lot No. 34 Geo. W. Sink's Subdivision, and the alley east of Loraine avenue, from River street to McKinley avenue, in the City of Columbus, Ohio, be and the same are hereby vacated.

Sec. 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE, No. 25535, To levy a special assessment upon the lots and lands benefited by the construction of a sewer upon the lines therein mentioned.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of constructing a sewer on Schiller street, from the alley west of Linwood avenue to Wilson avenue, Wilson avenue, from Schiller street to Reinhard avenue and the alley north of Reinhard avenue, from Wilson avenue to Oakwood avenue, in the City of Columbus, Ohio, as reported to the Council on October 24, 1910, by the estimating board heretofore appointed for that purpose, and which report was filed in the office of the city clerk on October 24, 1910, be and the same is hereby confirmed, and that there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands described in said report, the several amounts as therein set forth. It is hereby determined and declared that each of said lots and lands are specially benefited by said improvement and in amount equal to said assessment.

Sec. 2. That the total assessment shall be payable at the office of the City Treasurer of Columbus, Ohio, within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of the first publication of this ordinance with interest at the rate of four and one-half per cent. from the first day of September, 1910, or at the option of the owner in five annual installments with interest at the rate of four and one-half per cent. per annum upon deferred payments at the office of the County Treasurer after the same has been certified to the County Auditor for collection in the manner provided by law. The said assessment after being so certified may however be paid in full or by any number of annual installments at any tax collection time, with interest on same semi-annual interest day next ensuing. If said installments of said assessment be not paid when same become due a penalty will be imposed and collected as provided by law.

Sec. 3. That the said assessment and portions thereof when collected shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued for said improvement and the interest thereon as the same shall become due, and to no other purpose whatsoever.

AN ORDINANCE, No. 25534, To name or rename certain streets therein mentioned or described, in the city of Columbus, Ohio:

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbus, State of Ohio.

Section 1. That the streets herein mentioned or described, between the limits named, be and the same are hereby named or renamed as set forth in the following schedule, to wit:

Abbott avenue, from Summit street to east corporation line, to Alden avenue; Adams avenue, from alley west of Doyle avenue to Cleveland avenue (Harbor road), to Arlington avenue; Adams street, from Chase street north, second east St. Clair avenue, to Aldrich avenue; Atcheson avenue free pike, from Fifth avenue north to corporation line, to Joyce avenue; Ayrault street, from Goodale street to Buttles avenue, to Delaware avenue; Atcheson street, from Taylor avenue to Nelson avenue, to Maryland avenue; Adams street, from Jackson pike to west corporation line, to Griggs avenue; Bennett street, from Leonard avenue to Fifth avenue, to Bassett avenue; Babbert avenue, from 200 feet east Parsons avenue to east corporation line, to Southwood avenue; Belknap avenue, from Cleveland avenue (Harbor road) to east terminus, Twelfth avenue; Buttles avenue, from Johnstown road to Nelson avenue, Fifth avenue; Bonham street, from St. Clair avenue to east terminus, to Bonham avenue; Catherine avenue, from Fifth avenue north, first west of Woodland avenue, to Chester avenue; Clinton avenue, from Cleveland avenue to east terminus fourth north of Fifth avenue, to Camden avenue; Shattuck avenue and its extension running north from Mock road to Arcadia avenue, from Arcadia avenue to north terminus, to Glen Echo drive; Columbus and Harrisburg pike, from Sandusky street to Central avenue, to Mound street; Columbus and Johnstown pike, from Atcheson street to south line St. Mary's academy, to Sunbury avenue; Columbus and Johnstown pike, from west line St. Mary's academy to Alum creek, to Leonard avenue; Duxbury avenue, from Indianola avenue to Summit street, to Wyandotte avenue; Doherty street, from Wall street to Front street first south of Vine street, to Red Bird alley; Doyle avenue, from Fifth avenue to C. S. & H. Ry. first west of Cleveland avenue, to Denman avenue; Dove avenue, from Eighth street to Cleveland avenue, to Dow avenue; Dayton avenue, from Mock road (south) to north corporation line, to Indianola avenue; Eighth street, from Cleveland avenue to Woodruff avenue, to Essex avenue; Eleventh street, from Woodward avenue to Abram avenue, to Eden avenue; Earhart avenue, from west line Merion subdivision to corporation line, to Markinson avenue; East street, from alley north Wyandotte avenue to Mock road, to Fourth street; Elizabeth street, from Cleveland avenue to west terminus, to Reynolds avenue; Front street, from Vine street to First avenue, to Park street; Franklin street, from Greenlawn avenue north to river, to Filmore avenue; First street, from Summit street to East street, to Tompkins street; Franklin and Jackson pike, from Mound street to Greenlawn avenue, to Harmon avenue; Garfield avenue, from Sheldon avenue to Babbert avenue, to Wager street; Gifford avenue, from Howard street to St. Clair avenue, to Gibbard avenue; Gray avenue, from Joyce avenue to C. A. & C. Ry., to Fourth avenue; Harrison street, from Glenwood avenue to Rodgers avenue, to Cable avenue; Harbor road, Lockwin road, Columbus and Westerville pike, from Main track; Central Ohio R. R. to north corporation line, to Cleveland avenue; Haviland avenue, from Broad street to Main street, to Nelson road; Henrietta avenue, from Belknap avenue to north of Windsor avenue, to Dell avenue; Hill street, from P. C. & St. L. Ry. north, second east Johnstown pike, to Pike avenue; alley east of High street

and south of State street, from State street to Pearl street, from State street southwardly and eastwardly to Wall street, to Bunker alley; Home avenue, from Hayes avenue to Taylor avenue, to Maryland avenue; Indianola avenue, from Summit street to east corporation line, to Iuka avenue; Lane street, from St. Clair avenue east, second north of N. & W. Ry., to Dupont avenue; Mock road, from High street to Indianola avenue, to Arcadia avenue; Mock road, from Mock road south to mock road north, to Indianola avenue; Mock road, from Indianola avenue to corporation line, to Hudson street; Mozart street, from Deshler avenue to Hanford street, to Fourth street; Logan street, from Fifth avenue to Léona avenue, to Mingo avenue; McCort avenue, from 200 feet east Parsons avenue to Ann street, to Hinman avenue; Maynard street, from Summit street to East street, to Maynard avenue; Monroe avenue, from Sheldon avenue to Babbert avenue, to Ann street; Neil and Innis free pike, from C. C. & St. L. Ry. to Cleveland avenue, to Seventeenth avenue; Ninth street, from First avenue to Fifth avenue and C. S. & H. Ry. to Woodward avenue, to Milo avenue; Nelson avenue, from Broad street to Columbus and Johnstown pike, to Nelson road; Pietrey avenue, from Belknap avenue to Windsor avenue, to Brooks avenue. Powell road, from Nelson avenue to Alum creek, to Maryland avenue; Ridgeway street, from Nelson avenue to east terminus, to Ridgeway avenue; Railroad street, from Twelfth avenue to Neil and Innis pike, to Shawnee avenue; Scott street, from Taylor avenue to alley east Swan street, to Patton avenue; Seventh street, from C. S. & H. Ry. to Woodward avenue, to Grogan avenue; Shoemaker avenue, from St. Clair avenue to east terminus, to Olmsted avenue; Spring avenue, from alley west of Doyle avenue to Cleveland avenue, to Lockwin avenue; Swan street, from Leonard avenue north and south, first east of Taylor avenue, to Brighton avenue; Scotch street, from Fifth avenue to C. S. & H. Ry., to Fields avenue; South street, from Summit street to East street, to Clinton street; Shepard avenue, from Johnstown pike to Nelson avenue, to Margaret avenue; Seymour street, from Rennick street to Adams street, to Souder avenue; Sunbury pike, from Johnstown pike to corporation line, to Sunbury avenue; Third avenue, from west line Terrace View addition to Howard street, to Howard street, to Sheldon avenue; Tenth street, from First avenue to alley north Gibbard avenue and from Dove avenue to Twelfth avenue, to Kingry street; Twelfth street, from Woodward avenue to alley north of Abram avenue, to Wright avenue; Wood avenue, from Parsons avenue to 200 feet east, to Newell avenue; Woodward avenue, from C. C. & St. L. Ry. to Cleveland avenue, to Eleventh avenue; Wyandotte avenue, from alley north of Broad street to Long street, to Callender avenue; Second street east of Cleveland avenue, from North from Windsor avenue to Brooks avenue; first street south of Fifth avenue, from Taylor avenue to Bennett street, to Fourth avenue; first street south of Windsor avenue, from Cleveland avenue to second street east, to Thirteenth avenue; first street east of Cleveland avenue from School street to first street north of Belknap street, to Isabel avenue; second street east of Cleveland avenue, from School street to first street north of Belknap street, to Gerald avenue; first street east of Johnstown road, from Ridgeway avenue to Shepard avenue, to Wakcutt avenue; first street west of Franklin and Jackson pike, from Harrisburg pike to Renick street, to Souder avenue; second street west of Franklin and Jackson pike, from Harrisburg pike to Renick street, to Mt. Calvary avenue; first street south of Harrisburg pike, from Jackson pike to first street west, to Elmore avenue; Shelby street, from Gilbert street to Champion avenue, to Mooberry street; Hawthorne street, from Champion avenue to Taylor avenue, to Hawthorne avenue; Kimball street, from Kelton avenue to Lilley avenue, to Mooberry street; Walters avenue, from Sullivant avenue to second alley north, to Pavey avenue.
