AN ORDINANCE No. 274-52—To authorize the Director of Public Service to extend Contract No. 2260 with the Ohio Mineral Resources Consultants, Inc., for additional core borings of rock formation at the proposed site of the Hoover dam on Big Walnut Creek, for the Division of Water, Department of Public Service and to appropriate the money therefor.

Whereas, it was found necessary to obtain further surface information in the vicinity of the spillway outlet channel downstream and make additional core borings on land acquired by the city on the upstream side of the dam and obtain test cores to determine the location and extent of bridge footers at the sites of the bridge crossing the reservoir; and,

Whereas, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the Division of Water, Department of Public Service in that it is immediately necessary to make the test borings of rock and soil formations to facilitate the preparation of the plans and specifications for the Hoover dam; and,

Whereas, this project is necessary to provide adequate water storage and supply for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, property and safety of the city of Columbus and the inhabitants thereof; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service be and he is hereby authorized to extend Contract No. 2260 with The Ohio Mineral Resources Consultants, Inc. to cover additional core borings on land acquired by the city on the upstream side of the dam and obtain test cores to determine the location and extent of bridge footers at sites of the bridge crossing the reservoir.

Sec. 2. That the sum of \$6500, or as much thereof as may be needed be and the same is hereby appropriated from Waterworks Enlargement Fund No. 13 to pay the cost and expense thereof.

Sec. 3. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto which is made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the mayor.

AN ORDINANCE No. 275-52—To authorize the board of purchase to advertise for bids and enter into contract for the purchase of one 4-inch portable gasoline powered centrifugal water pump, together with discharge hose, and to appropriate funds to pay the cost thereof.

Whereas, the 4-inch pump now in use in the division of sewerage and drainage was purchased in 1938 and has been subjected to intensive use during the intervening period, and

Whereas, the age and condition of this pump is such that it is in need of extensive overhaul and it is no longer possible to obtain the repair parts needed to restore it to the dependable condition necessary in connection with sewer maintenance activities, and

Whereas, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the department of public service, division of sewerage and drainage, in that it is immediately necessary to purchase one

new 4-inch portable, gasoline powered centrifugal water pump, together with discharge hose, to facilitate sewer maintenance activities in order to protect the public health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the board of purchase be and it is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the purchase of one 4-inch portable gasoline powered centrifugal water pump, together with discharge hose, in accordance with the specifications therefor on file in the office of the said board of purchase.

Sec. 2. That the sum of \$1,500 or so much thereof as may be needed, be and it is hereby appropriated from the sewers and drains No. 72-A-700 fund to pay the cost thereof.

Sec. 3. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the mayor.

AN ORDINANCE No. 276-52—To vacate the first alley north of Brownlee avenue, from Kellner road to the first alley east of Kellner road.

Whereas, petition, signed by the owner of all lots and lands abutting upon the first alley north of Brownlee avenue, from Kellner road to the first alley east of Kellner road, was duly presented to this council, praying for and consenting to the vacation of said alley, between the limits named, and

Whereas, council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for in said petition, that it will not be detrimental to the general interests and ought to be made; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the first alley north of Brownlee avenue, from Kellner road to the first alley east of Kellner road, be and the same is hereby vacated.

AN ORDINANCE No. 277-52—To assent to the detachment of certain territory from the city of Columbus, Ohio.

Whereas, a section of the Olentangy river road, south of Henderson road, has been relocated, straightened and improved, and in order to carry out this improvement, it was necessary to move in an easterly direction the Olentangy river channel opposite thereto, and

Whereas said road is a county road and said changes have caused the new road section to be relocated within the corporate limits of the city of Columbus, and

Whereas, it is necessary that certain territory be detached from the city of Columbus, consisting of the territory lying between the present city of Columbus corporation line (being the former west bank of the Olentangy river) and the proposed city of Co-

lumbus corporation line (being the present west bank of said river) in order that the county may have jurisdiction over said road, all as shown upon a plat entitled "Relocation of Olentangy River Channel, River Road and Corporation Line," and

Whereas, certain freehold electors owning portions of said territory have petitioned the commissioners of Franklin county, Ohio, in accordance with law, to detach said territory from the city of Columbus, Ohio, and

Whereas, before said commissioners can entertain said petition, section 3577, General Code of Ohio, requires the council of the municipal corporation interested therein to assent to said detachment; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the council of the city of Columbus, Ohio, does hereby assent to the detachment from said city of Columbus, Ohio, the following described territory:

Beginning at a point on the west bank of the Olentangy river, said point being 176 feet west of the centerline of the present river channel at station 17 + 90 as shown on the construction plans for Olentangy river road, section "D", Ohio Project No. S-854 (2) on file in the Franklin county Engineer's office; thence in a northwesterly direction along the former boundary of the Olentangy river, crossing the present centerline of the Olentangy river road at station 53 + 85 to a point 88 feet west of the present centerline of the Olentangy river road at station 56 + 00; thence in a northerly direction west of the present centerline of the Olentangy river road and along the former boundary of the Olentangy river to a point 75 feet west of the present centerline of the Olentangy river road at station 65 + 00; thence in a northeasterly direction along the former boundary of the Olentangy river, crossing the present centerline of the Olentangy river road at station 67 + 00 to a point on the west bank of the Olentangy river, said point being 122 feet west of the centerline of the present river channel at station 43 + 00; thence in a southerly direction along the present west bank of the Olentangy river to the place of beginning and there to terminate, containing the territory between the present city of Columbus corporation line or the former west bank of the Olentangy river and the proposed city of Columbus corporation line, or the present west bank of said Olentangy river.
