

AN ORDINANCE No. 547-58—To authorize and direct the Board of Purchase to advertise for bids and enter into contracts for the purchase of fuel oil, lubricating oil, chemical lime and ferric chloride for use at the Sewage Treatment Works, and to appropriate funds to pay the cost thereof.

Be it ordained by the council of the City of Columbus:

Section 1. That the Board of Purchase be and it is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into contracts for the purchase of the following supplies for use at the Sewage Treatment Works during the twelve months period ending June 30, 1959: approximately 500,000 gallons of fuel oil, approximately 10,000 gallons of lubricating oil, approximately 1,800 tons of chemical lime, and approximately 500 tons of ferric chloride.

Sec. 2. That the sum of \$145,000, or so much thereof as may be needed, be and it is hereby appropriated from Sewage Treatment Works fund No. 71A-010 B to pay the cost thereof.

Sec. 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE No. 548-58—To authorize a cooperative agreement between the City of Columbus and the United States Geological Survey for the purpose of investigating surface water resources.

Whereas, it is to the City's interest to continue operation of the existing river-measurement station on the Scioto River at the Sewage Treatment Works in order to obtain accurate information on the river flow at that point; and,

Whereas, the United States Geological Survey will continue to operate this station, as it has during many years past, if the City will continue to share the expense thereof; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute a cooperative agreement with the United States Geological Survey for the continued operation of the river-measurement station at the Sewage Treatment Works during the period from January 1, 1958 through June 30, 1959.

Sec. 2. That the sum of \$450.00 be and it is hereby appropriated from Sewage Treatment Works Fund No. 71A-010 C-44 for the purpose of paying the City's share of the expense thereof.

Sec. 3. That the City Auditor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the City Treasurer for the City's share of the expense of operating the river-measurement station at the Sewage Treatment Works upon receipt of a voucher approved by the Director of Public Service.

Sec. 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE No. 550-58—To authorize the director of public service to advertise for bids and to enter into contract for the improvement of Gay street from Front street to Civic Center drive; and Long street, from Marconi boulevard to Civic Center drive.

Whereas, the department of highways of the state of Ohio plans to receive bids for the improvement of U. S. Route 33 within the next several months, and

Whereas, in connection therewith, the improvement of Gay and Long streets, between the points designated, should be made; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the director of public service be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and to enter into contract for the improvement of Gay street, from Front street to Civic Center drive; and Long street, from Marconi boulevard to Civic Center drive, by applying a bituminous tack coat and asphaltic concrete leveling and surface courses, in accordance with the plan marked 1770, drawer D, and the specifications therefor, on file in the office of said director, which are hereby approved.

Sec. 2. That the sum of \$9,400.00, or so much thereof as may be needed, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the maintenance and repair No. 65-602 fund, to pay the cost thereof.

AN ORDINANCE No. 551-58—To accept the proposal of Claprod and Mackan, florists, 500 S. High street, to lease a parcel of city owned land abutting the north side of Greenlawn avenue and extending westwardly from Scioto boulevard.

Whereas, Claprod and Mackan, florists, have through Donald L. Beckett, attorney-at-law, 20 East Broad street, proposed the leasing of the hereinafter described city owned parcel of land during the period beginning May 17, 1958 and ending May 31, 1958, for the purpose of selling flowers during said period and to pay the city the sum of \$100.00 therefor, and

Whereas, it is the sense of this council that said proposal should be accepted; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the proposal of Claprod and Mackan, florists, 500 South High street, submitted through Donald L. Beckett, attorney-at-law, 20 East Broad street, to lease the hereinafter described parcel of city owned land for the period beginning May 17, 1958 and ending May 31, 1958, for the purpose of selling flowers and to pay to the city of Columbus therefor the sum of

\$100.00, said \$100.00 to be paid in advance:

Being a strip of land 20.6 feet in width off the south end of a 13.46 acre tract now owned by the city of Columbus, said 20.6 foot strip of land being adjacent to and parallel to the north right-of-way line of Greenlawn avenue and extending from the westerly right-of-way line of Scioto boulevard, to a point 390 feet westerly thereof.

Sec. 2. That the director of public service be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute the necessary lease agreement on behalf of the city and to deposit the proceeds therefrom in the city treasury to the credit of the permanent improvement fund.

Sec. 3. That upon the expiration of the terms of said lease, the lessee shall forthwith cause the land so occupied to be surrendered in as good condition as it now is to the satisfaction of said director of public service.

Sec. 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE No. 553-58—To change the names of Sullivant avenue South and Jewel road, and to repeal ordinance No. 423-58, passed March 24, 1958.

Whereas, the name of Sullivant avenue South, extending from Georgesville road to Sullivant avenue, is easily confused with the name of Sullivant avenue lying north thereof and is, to a certain extent, a duplication of street names, and

Whereas, Jewel road from the south terminus of Barnett road to the extreme south terminus of Jewel road is a direct continuation of said Barnett road, and

Whereas, the names of Sullivant avenue South and Jewel road between the points named should be changed; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the name of Sullivant avenue South extending from Georgesville road to Sullivant avenue be and it is hereby changed to Atlanta drive.

Sec. 2. That the name of Jewel road from the south terminus of Barnett road to the extreme south terminus of said Jewel road be and it is hereby changed to Barnett road.

Sec. 3. That ordinance No. 423-58, passed March 24, 1958, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE No. 554-58—To amend Section 26.2 of the City Code of Columbus, Ohio, by repealing Ordinance No. 1501-54, in order to eliminate the public market stands on Main Street. Whereas, it is the sense of this council on the recommendation of the Traffic Commission of the City of Columbus, Ohio, that it is desirable to eliminate the public market stands on Main Street in order to alleviate the congested traffic condition thereon, now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 1501-54 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. That the Code of the City of Columbus, Ohio, 1952, Chapter 26, Markets, Article 1, Section 26.2 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 26.2 Location of Central and East Markets.

The Public market of the city shall be held in the following locations, which shall be known and designated as follows: The market house on Fourth Street; the east side of Fourth Street, from a point one hundred and twenty-five feet north of State Street, south to Livingston Avenue, and the west side of Fourth Street, from Town Street south to Main Street; the north side of Rich Street, from Fourth Street to the west line of the market house; and the south side of Town Street, from Fourth Street to the west line of the market house, shall be known as the Central Market.

The market house located on Mt. Vernon Avenue at Nineteenth Street, the south side of Mt. Vernon Avenue, from Nineteenth Street to the east line of the market house; the east side of Nineteenth Street, from Mt. Vernon Avenue south to the first alley, and the alleys along the south and east sides of such market house shall be known as the East Market.

Sec. 3. That if any section of this ordinance or part thereof, or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of sections or parts thereof to other persons or circumstances, shall not be affected thereby.

Sec. 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after June 1, 1958.

AN ORDINANCE No. 555-58—To authorize and direct the Director of Public Service to enter into modification of existing leases between the City of Columbus and Trans World Airlines, American Airlines, Eastern Airlines, Lake Central Airlines and Piedmont Airlines to provide for space requirements and space rental charges in the New Terminal Building and the AMF-Cargo Building now under construction at the Municipal Airport, Port Columbus.

Whereas, American Airlines, Trans World Airlines, Eastern Airlines, Lake Central Airlines and Piedmont Airlines have existing leases for space rental at Port Columbus; and

Whereas, existing leases with the above mentioned airlines recognize the necessity for the establishment of space requirements and rate charges for space used exclusively and in common by the air transport operators prior to the occupancy of the New Terminal and AMF-Cargo Buildings at the Columbus Municipal Airport, Port Columbus; and

Whereas, the Metropolitan Airport and Aviation Commission has established and recommended a schedule of space rental charges for a five-year period from the date of occupancy of the New Terminal building and AMF-Cargo building at Port Columbus; and

Whereas, it is now necessary to modify the existing leases prior to occupancy of the building due to the considerable time required to complete contractual modifications with the airlines; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service be and hereby is authorized to enter into a modification of the existing leases between the City of Columbus and Trans World Airlines, Inc., American Airlines, Inc., Eastern Air Lines, Inc., Lake Central Airlines,

Inc. and Piedmont Airlines, Inc. based on the established space requirements and the approved schedule of rental charges for space used exclusively and in common in the New Terminal Building and AMF-Cargo buildings, Port Columbus.

Sec. 2. That the space rental charges so provided for are to remain in effect for a period of five years from date of occupancy of the New Terminal and AMF-Cargo buildings.

Sec. 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
