Whereas, said reserve also abuts the east line of Zettler Road extending southwardly to a point in the north line of Lot No. 1, extended westwardly, of Liv-Moor Heights (Plat Book 26, Page 41, Franklin County Recorder's Office) and is needed for dedication as a part of Zettler Road, and

Whereas, the acquisition of the whole of said parcel by one transaction is the most feasible and economical manner of procedure; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the City Attorney be and he is hereby authorized and directed to acquire the whole of the hereinafter described parcel of real estate, designated as a reserve, a portion of which is within the right-of-way of Livingston Avenue at the intersection of Zettler Road and the remaining portion thereof abutting Zettler Road:

One Foot Reserve

"Situated within the corporate limits of the City of Columbus, Franklin County, Ohio, and being that part of a reserve, one foot in width, conveyed to Willard and Mary L. Brenning as of record in Deed Book 1724, Page 111, Franklin County Recorder's Office and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center line of Livingston Avenue and the northwest corner of said one foot reserve, said point being also in the east line of Zettler Road extended northwardly; thence eastwardly with said center line of Livingston Avenue, a distance of one foot to a point marking the northeast corner of said reserve and the northwest corner of a one acre tract now owned by Bexley Post 430, American Legion; thence southwardly with the east line of said one foot reserve and the west line of said one acre tract, a distance of 300.41 feet, (300 feet by deed) to a point in the north line of Lot No. 1, extended westwardly, of Liv-Moor Heights (Plat Book 26, Page 41, Recorder's Office, Franklin County); thence westwardly with said north line of Lot No. 1 extended, a distance of 1.0 foot to a point in the east line of Zettler Road; thence northwardly with the east line of Zettler Road and the west line of said one foot reserve, a distance of 300.41 feet (300.0 feet by deed) to the place of beginning.

Sec. 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Whereas, petition, signed by the owners of all lots and lands abutting upon the alleys west of Enfield Road and north of Bexley Park Road, was duly presented to this council, praying for and consenting to the vacation of said alleys, between the points named, and

Whereas, council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacations as prayed for in said petition, that they will not be detrimental to the general interests and ought to be made; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the alley west of Enfield Road, from the north line of Bexley Park Road to the north line of Lot No. 33 of Bexley Park Extension, and the alley north of Bexley Park Road, from the east line of Harding Road to the west line of the alley west of Enfield Road, be and the same are hereby vacated.

Sec. 2. That the City of Columbus reserves the right to operate and maintain any and all sewers, water lines and any other public utilities owned by the City, and that the right is reserved to operate and maintain any other public utilities, if any, now existing on or in said alleys hereby vacated, and shall have the right to enter thereon at any time for the purpose of replacing, operating and maintaining the same.

Sec. 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE No. 575-60—To vacate the alley north of Fair Avenue, extending from the west line of Brookside Drive to the east line of the alley west of Brookside Drive.

Whereas, petition, signed by the owners of all lots and lands abutting upon the alley north of Fair Avenue, from Brookside Drive to the alley west of Brookside Drive, was duly presented to this council, praying for and consenting to the vacation of said alley, between the points named, and

Whereas, council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for in said petition, that it will not be detrimental to the general interests and ought to be made; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the alley north of Fair Avenue, extending from the west line of Brookside Drive, to the east line of the alley west of Brookside Drive, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Sec. 2. That the City of Columbus reserves the right to operate and maintain any and all sewers, water lines and any other public utilities owned by the city, and that the right is reserved to operate and maintain any other public utilities, if any, now existing on or in said alley hereby vacated, and shall have the right to enter thereon at any time for the purpose of replacing, operating and maintaining the same.

Sec. 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE No. 576-60—To vacate Arnett Road, Westwood Road, Deland Avenue, alley south of Deland Avenue, alley south of Westwood Road and alley east of Arnett Road, between specified limits, and running through a portion of Whetstone Park.

Whereas, at a meeting of the Columbus Park Commission held on April 6, 1960, the vacation of certain streets and alleys running through a portion of Whetstone Park was approved, and

Whereas, council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacations as approved by the Columbus Park Commission, that they will not be detrimental to the general interests and ought to be made, now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That Arnett Road, from the south line of Deland Avenue southwardly to its south terminus; Westwood Road, from the west line of the first alley west of Olentangy Boulevard and the east line of Lot No. 51 of Webster Estates Addition extended northwardly, westwardly to the east line of Arnett Road; Deland Avenue, from a point 440.0 feet westerly of the west line of Scenic Drive (as measured along the north line of Deland Avenue) westwardly to its west terminus; alley south of Deland Avenue, from the west line of Lot No. 7 of Rose Gardens Subdivision extended southwardly, westwardly to Arnett Road; alley south of Westwood Road, from a point 250.0 feet west of the west line of Olentangy Boulevard, westwardly to the east line of the alley east of Arnett Road; and alley east of Arnett Road, from the south line of Westwood Road, southwardly to its south terminus, and from the north line of Westwood Road northwardly to the south line of the alley south of Deland Avenue, be and the same are hereby vacated.

Sec. 2. That the City of Columbus reserves the right to operate and maintain the 24-inch storm sewer in Deland Avenue, and shall have the right to enter thereon at any time for the purpose of replacing, operating and maintaining the same.

Sec. 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
