AN ORDINANCE No. 6031.

To vacate a strip of Land on the West line of Hamlet Street from Warren Street to the first alley North of Warren Street, said strip lying 8 feet wide on Warren Street and 2 feet wide on said alley.

Whereas: On the 12th day of January 1891, a petition was presented to Council for the vacation of a strip of land on the West side of Hamlet Street from Warren Street to the first alley North of Warren Street:

Notice of the pendency and prayer of which has been given as required by law, and

Whereas: upon hearing, the Council is satisfied there is good cause for said vacation, and the same would not be detrimental to the general interest and should be made, therefore

Section I

Be it ordained by the City-Council of the City of Columbus that said strip of land on the West side of Hamlet Street from Warren Street to the first alley North of Warren Street, 8 feet wide in Warren Street and 2 feet wide in said alley be vacated and the same is hereby vacated.

Section II

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication according to law.
