

## ORDINANCES

**AN ORDINANCE No. 397-46**—To authorize the payment of wages to employees in all divisions of the service department injured in the line of duty, for the six days succeeding such injury.

Whereas, under existing state laws, the industrial commission does not pay claims for injuries occurring in the line of duty for the first six days thereafter, and

Whereas, such employees, therefore, lose their normal compensation by reason of such injury; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the city auditor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to honor payrolls carrying the names of employees in all divisions of the service department injured in the line of duty, for the first six days next succeeding the date of such injury.

Sec. 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**AN ORDINANCE No. 619-46**—To vacate an alley and to dedicate city owned property for alley purposes.

Whereas, the city of Columbus is the owner of property between Gault street and Kent street east of Miller avenue which is used for recreational purposes, and

Whereas, the use of said property to the fullest extent demands the vacation of a portion of the 25 foot alley between Kent street and Gault street, extending from the first alley east of Miller avenue a distance of 31.5 feet, more or less, east thereof, and

Whereas, such vacation demands the dedication of ground to provide alley purposes; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That that portion of the 25 foot alley between Kent street and Gault street, extending from the first alley east of Miller avenue to a line 2.5 feet west of the west line of lot No. 11 of Charles R. Cornell's subdivision, extended across said alley, being a distance of 31.5 feet, more or less, be and it is hereby vacated.

Sec. 2. That the city of Columbus reserves the right to operate and maintain any and all sewers, water lines and any other public utilities owned by said city, and that the right is reserved to operate any and all other public utilities, if any, now existing in or on said alley so vacated, and shall have the right to enter thereon at any time for the purpose of operating, maintaining and replacing the same.

Sec. 3. That a strip of land 15 feet in width between the first and second alleys east of Miller avenue, extending from Kent street to the alley south thereof, and being 2.5 feet off the east side of lots 10 and 11 of Charles R. Cornell's subdivision (plat book 5, page 227, recorder's office, Franklin county, Ohio), and 12.5 feet off the west side of the adjacent 20 foot alley vacated by ordinance No. 33371, passed June 5, 1922, be and it is hereby dedicated to public use for alley purposes.

Sec. 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**AN ORDINANCE No. 675-46**—To change the zoning map attached to ordinance No. 38852 passed February 27, 1928, and as subsequently amended as herein provided.

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the zoning map attached to ordinance No. 38852, passed February 27, 1928, and as subsequently amended be and the same is hereby revised by changing the zoning of the property being lots 28 and 29 of John Morrison's Subdivision, located on the north side of Hildreth avenue, between Bolivar and Twentieth street from a B-1 dwelling district to a B-1 first industrial district and the engineer of the planning commission be and he is hereby authorized and directed to make the said change on the said original zoning map in the office of the division of building regulation and the office of the city engineer.

Sec. 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**AN ORDINANCE No. 691-46**—To accept the deed of Frank B. Hyatt and Ola F. Hyatt, his wife, dated December 4, 1946; to dedicate the premises therein conveyed to public use for street and alley purposes, and to name one parcel so dedicated.

Whereas, Frank B. Hyatt and Ola F. Hyatt, his wife, have proposed to deed to the city certain parcels of land for street and alley purposes, and

Whereas, it is the sense of this council that such deed should be accepted; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the deed of Frank B. Hyatt and Ola F. Hyatt, his wife, dated December 4, 1946, for the following described premises:

### PARCEL No. 1

Situated in the state of Ohio, county of Franklin, and in the city of Columbus, and being part of a tract of ground conveyed by the C. C. C. & St. L. Railway company to the C. D. & M. Electric company, as the same is shown of record in deed book 748, page 337, recorder's office, Franklin county, Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in the south line of Indianola Highlands addition at its intersection with the east line of the west part of Kensington court, as shown on the plat of Indianola Highlands addition, of record in plat book 9, page 32, recorder's office, Franklin county, Ohio; thence south 3° 18' west with said east line produced southerly, 117.44 feet to an iron pin in the north line of Glen Echo parcels, as shown of record in plat book 9, page 9, recorder's office, Franklin county, Ohio; thence with said north line, south 86° 58' west 50.31 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of said north line with the west line of the west part of Kensington court produced southerly; thence with said west line produced, north 3° 18' east 123.6 feet to an iron pin in the south line of Indianola Highlands addition; thence with said south line, south 86° 10' east 50 feet to the place of beginning.

### PARCEL No. 2

Situated in the state of Ohio, county of Franklin, and in the city of Columbus, and being part of a tract of ground conveyed by the C. C. C. & St. L. Railway company to the C. D. & M. Electric company, as the same is shown of record in deed book 748, page 337, recorder's office, Franklin county, Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in the south line of Indianola Highlands addition at its intersection with the east line of the alley between Indianola avenue and Kensington Place west produced southerly, as said alley is shown on the plat of Indianola Highlands addition, of record in plat book 9, page 32, recorder's office, Franklin county, Ohio; thence from said beginning point, south 2° 59' west, with the east line of said alley produced southerly, 138.17 feet to an iron pin in the north line of Glen Echo parcels, as shown of record in plat book 9, page 9, recorder's office, Franklin county, Ohio; thence with said north line, south 86° 58' west 142.77 feet to an iron pin in the east line of Indianola avenue; thence with said east line, north 2° 59' east 16.08 feet to a stake; thence north 86° 58' east, parallel to and 16.0 feet from the north line of Glen Echo parcels, 126.69 feet to an iron pin in the west line of the alley between Indianola avenue and Kensington Place west in Indianola Highlands addition produced southerly; thence with said west line produced, north 2° 59' east 124.02 feet to an iron pin in the south line of Indianola Highlands addition; thence with said south line, south 86° 10' east 16 feet to the place of beginning.

### PARCEL No. 3

Situated in the state of Ohio, county of Franklin, and in the city of Columbus, and being part of a tract of ground conveyed by the C. C. C. & St. L. Railway company to the C. D. & M. Electric company, as the same is shown of record in deed book 748, page 337, recorder's office, Franklin county, Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of the east line of Kensington Place west and the south line of an 8 foot alley along the south side of Indianola Highlands addition, as shown on the plat of said addition of record in plat book 9, page 32, recorder's office, Franklin county, Ohio; thence eastwardly with the south line of said alley a distance of 385.31 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of said south line of said alley and the west line of Kensington Place east; thence with the said south line of said alley extended eastwardly a distance of 59.49 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of the south line of a 16 foot alley along the south side of said addition and the east line of Kensington Place east; thence westwardly a distance of 52.2 feet, more or less, to the point of intersection of the west line of Kensington Place east extended southwardly and a line 8 feet southerly of and parallel to the south line of the said 8 foot alley along the south line of said addition; thence westwardly with a line 8 feet southerly of and parallel to the said 8 foot alley a distance of 384.2 feet, more or less, to the intersection of said line and the east line of Kensington Place west extended southwardly; thence northwardly with the said east line of said Kensington Place west extended, a distance of 8 feet to the place of beginning;

be and the same is hereby accepted and the premises therein conveyed are hereby dedicated to public use for street and alley purposes.

Sec. 2. That the premises so dedicated in said deed as parcel No. 1 be and it is hereby named Kensington Place west.

Sec. 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
