AN ORDINANCE No. 741-57—To name the presently designated Gahanna-Southern road within the corporate limits of the city, and to name the continuation of East Fifth avenue.

Whereas, a portion of the presently designated Gahanna-Southern road, extending through the easterly portion of Port Columbus, is now within the corporate limits of the city of Columbus and is a direct continuation of Hamilton road, extending southwardly, and the name of said road should be Hamilton road, and

Whereas, Fifth avenue has been extended in a northeasterly direction to an intersection with the presently designated Gahanna-Southern road and is unnamed; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the name of the presently designated Gahanna-Southern road, extending from the south corporation line of Gahanna to the north right-of-way line of the Baltimore and Ohio railroad, be and it is hereby officially determined to be Hamilton road.

Sec. 2. That the unnamed portion of Fifth avenue, extending from a point opposite the southeasterly terminus of the northwest-southeast runway to its intersection with the Gahanna-Southern road (Hamilton road),

be and it is hereby named Fifth avenue. Sec. 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the mayor.

AN ORDINANCE No. 744-57—To authorize and direct the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with a competent and accredited engineer or engineering firm to make an engineering survey, a preliminary design with estimated costs and recommendations, and then, when ordered, to prepare detailed plans, specifications, estimates of quantities and cost and to assist in the acquisition of necessary easements for the construction of the Big Walnut Sanitary Trunk Sewer together with a temporary force main and pumping station outlet near Livingston Avenue and for the construction of a proposed East Broad Street and Taylor Station Road Area Sanitary Subtrunk Sewer to provide sanitary sewer service and relief in tributary drainage areas to the east and northeast and to appropriate funds to pay the cost thereof.

Whereas, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the Department of Public Service, Division of Sewerage and Drainage in that the indicated engineering work is needed as the earliest possible time to permit the construction of sanitary trunk sewers, a force main and pumping station and a sanitary subtrunk sewer to serve tributary drainage areas to the east and northeast, thereby preserving and protecting the public peace, health, property and safety; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with a competent and accredited engineer or engineering firm to make an engineering survey, a preliminary design with estimated costs and recommendations, and then, when ordered, to prepare detailed plans, specifications, estimates of quantities and cost and to assist in the acquisition of necessary easements for the construction of the Big Walnut Sanitary Trunk Sewer together with a temporary force main and pumping station outlet near Livingston Avenue and for the construction of a proposed East Broad Street and Taylor Station Road Area Sanitary Subtrunk Sewer to provide sanitary sewer service and relief in tributary drainage areas to the east and northeast.

Sec. 2. That the said engineer or engineering firm will conduct the work to the satisfaction of the Director of Public Service and the Chief Sewerage Engineer of the city of Columbus, Ohio.

Sec. 3. That the fees to be paid such engineer or engineering firm for services rendered shall not exceed the rates prescribed by the Ohio Society of Professional Engineers.

Sec. 4. That the sum of \$65,000 or so much thereof as may be needed, be and it is hereby appropriated from the monies now in the fund known as
