AN ORDINANCE No. 988-61—To authorize the exchange of tracts of land situated south of McKinley Avenue and east of Dry Run Creek, for the purpose of acquiring land on which part of the Dry Run Levee has been constructed, and for the purpose of maintaining said Levee.

Whereas, the council of the city of Columbus has heretofore passed an ordinance, to-wit: Ordinance No. 793-59, passed on the 8th day of June, 1959, appropriating a tract of land, described herein as Tract No. One, for the purpose of constructing the Dry Run Levee and authorizing the City Attorney to take appropriation proceedings; and

Whereas, the City Attorney has effected an agreement with the owners of Tract No. One, James A. Davis and Edgar M. Davis, wherein said owners agree to convey said Tract No. One to the city of Columbus in consideration of the conveyance of a tract of land, described herein as Tract No. Two, by the city of Columbus to said owners and for the additional consideration of the payment of the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) to said owners; and

Whereas, the tract of land described herein as Tract No. Two is no longer needed for municipal purposes; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the city of Columbus:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service be and he is hereby authorized and directed to purchase by warranty deed the following described property, designated Tract No. One:

Situated in the county of Franklin, state of Ohio, and in the city of Columbus, and being a part hereinafter described of Lot No. 16 of Jacob S. Sullivant's subdivision of Lot No. 15 of William S. Sullivant's farm of record in Plat Book 3, page 189, Franklin County Recorder's Office, the said part containing the property intended herein to be conveyed being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin located at the southeast corner of said Lot No. 16; thence westwardly with the south line of said lot and the curvature thereof a distance of 228.00 feet to an iron pin marking the true point of beginning; thence northeastwardly on a straight line including an angle of 62° 03' 30" with the tangent to the curve of the preceding course, a distance of 259.00 feet to an iron pin located at a distance of 105.00 feet measured westwardly at right angles from the east line of said Lot No. 16 at a point 224.98 feet measured northwardly from the said southeast corner of said lot; thence northwardly on a straight line including an angle to the west of 153° 48'
