

ORDINANCE NO. 10-32

To Vacate Alley Lying Immediately North of Goodale Boulevard between Kramer Avenue and Quay Avenue all as shown in the Recorded Plat of Grandview Park Hill Subdivision. said Subdivision being a part of the City of Grandview Heights, Franklin County, Ohio, and shown upon the blue print attached hereto and made a part hereof

WHEREAS

WHEREAS, on the 1st day of February, 1932, a petition by persons owning all the lots abutting on the sixteen-foot alley lying immediately north of Goodale Boulevard between Kramer Avenue and Quay Avenue, as shown in the recorded plat of Grandview Park Hill Subdivision, said subdivision being a part of the City of Grandview Heights, Franklin County, Ohio, and shown upon the blue print attached hereto and made a part hereof, was duly presented to Council, praying that said alley be vacated, and

WHEREAS, the written consent to the vacation of said alley by all abutting property owners thereon, has been filed with Council and as publication is required by law, and

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation of said alley as prayed for and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Grandview Heights, Ohio, three-fourths of all the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the sixteen-foot alley lying immediately north of Goodale Boulevard between Kramer Avenue and Quay Avenue, as shown in the recorded plat of Grandview Park Hill Subdivision, said subdivision being a part of the City of Grandview Heights, Franklin County, Ohio, and shown upon the blue print attached hereto and made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
