This day this cause came on to be heard upon the application of Don Huck and Robert Huck, through their petitions in writing, filed with the Clerk of this Court, praying that the plat known as William W. Ross Memorial Addition, an addition to the City of Grandview Heights, Ohio, be vacated.

Whereupon, the Court upon consideration thereof, finds that the applicants, Don Huck and Robert T. Huck, are the owners of more than two-thirds of the lots in said addition and that said applicants have given thirty days notice of the filing of their said petition, by publication in a newspaper printed and of general circulation in this County, as provided by the statute of Ohio; it is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that the prayer of said petition be granted and that the plat known as William W. Ross Memorial Addition, as recorded in the Recorder's Office, Franklin County, in Plat Book 26, page 36, and in Map Book M, page 96-B, in the Auditor's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, be and the same is hereby entirely vacated, together with the street and park therein.
