To Vacate a Part of Viola Avenue.

WHEREAS, THE City of Grandview Heights, Ohio, agreed to vacate that portion of Viola Avenue hereinafter described in connection with the construction of the Goodale Street, overhead crossing of The Chesapeake and Ohio Railway Company; and

WHEREAS, The Council of the City of Grandview Heights, Ohio, is satisfied that said overhead crossing has been completed and that the portion of Viola Avenue hereinafter described should be vacated in accordance with the understanding and agreement of the City of Grandview Heights, Ohio;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Grandview Heights, Ohio:

Section 1. That the following described portion of Viola Avenue in the City of Grandview Heights, Ohio, to-wit:

All that portion of Viola Avenue in the City of Grandview Heights, Ohio, together with all that portion of Lot No. 1 in Block 3 in Clayton's Sub-division in the City of Grandview Heights lying north of a line 250 ft. South of Goodale Boulevard and parallel thereto

be and the same hereby is vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


