Whereas the Council of the Village of Grandview Heights  
deems it necessary to alter Broadview Avenue between First Avenue and  
Goodale Boulevard in said Village: and

Whereas the owners of all the lots affected by such  
proposed alterations have requested council to make said alterations  
and have consented to said change, and have waived any and all claims  
for damages, and have filed their written consent and request that  
said street as altered shall be dedicated to public use without  
any appropriation proceedings, Therefore

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of  
Grandview Heights, State of Ohio,

Section 1. That Broadview Avenue as it formerly existed between First Avenue and Goodale Boulevard, be and it hereby is altered, and the location thereof is changed from the lines on the attached plat marked "Original Property Line", to the lines marked "Present Property Line adopted July 1914," on said plat, which said plat is marked "Exhibit A", and made a part hereof. The portion of said street hereby abandoned are clearly shown on said plat, and as the owners of all the property embraced within the new lines of said street have petitioned for and consented to said alterations, and have expressly waived all claims of every kind either to property or for damages, no appropriation proceedings are required.

Section 2. That the clerk be and he hereby is authorized and directed to present to the Recorder of Franklin County a certified copy of this ordinance and plat for record. *x See Plat Book 13 Page-9.*

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law:-
