Passed July 5, 2016

An Ordinance to Change the name of
Burrell Avenue to West First Avenue

Whereas, the Ohio Revised Code 723.04 gives the Grandview Heights City Council the authority to change the names of streets or alleys within the City; and

Whereas, the City is underway with a street construction process that will more directly align W. First Avenue and Burrell Avenue; and


Whereas, the owner and tenants of the remaining building with an address on Burrell Avenue support the street name change from Burrell Avenue to W. First Avenue; and

Whereas, changing the name of the street will not be detrimental to the general interest of the community and in fact serve the city desire to functionally and visually link the older community to the redevelopment to the Grandview Commerce District Planning Area now known as Grandview Yard.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW HEIGHTS, OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1. The street name of "Burrell Avenue" is hereby changed to "First Avenue".


SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest opportunity allowed by law.
