Vacation of an Avenue

Village of GrandView Heights. Columbus, Ohio.

An Ordinance No. 219 to vacate Fairview Ave. from Merrick Road (formerly Glenwood Ave.) south to Goodale Boulevard.

Whereas, on the 22nd day of December 1920, a petition, together with the written consent of the persons owning all the lots in the immediate vicinity of Fairview Avenue from Merrick Road (formerly Glenwood Ave.) to Goodale Boulevard, was presented to Council Praying that said street between the points named, be vacated; and

Whereas Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made.

Therefore Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Grandview Heights State of Ohio,

Section 1. That Fairview Avenue from Merrick Road (formerly Glenwood Ave.) south to Goodale Boulevard be and the same is hereby vacated.

Sec. 11. That this Ordinance shall be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
