AN ORDINANCE NO. 220 TO VACATE THE
ALLEY BETWEEN WESTWOOD AND GLENN AVENUES
FROM THE FIRST ALLEY SOUTH OF FIRST AVENUE
TO THE FIRST ALLEY NORTH OF BLUFF AVENUE.

WHEREAS ON THE 22nd day of Dec, 1920
a petition, together with the written consent of the persons
owning all the lots in the immediate vicinity of Westwood
and Glenn Avenues from the first alley south of First Avenue
to the First alley north of Bluff Avenue, was presented to
Council praying that said alley between the points named, be
vacated; and

WHEREAS Council upon hearing is satisfied that
there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, and that
it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought
to be made,

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the
Village of Grandview Heights, State of Ohio,

SECTION I: That the alley between Westwood and
Glenn Avenues from the first alley south of First Avenue to
the first alley north of Bluff Avenue be, and the same is
hereby vacated.

SECTION II: That this ordinance shall be in force
from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
