ORDINANCE NO. 510 -27

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Grandview Heights, three-fourths of all the members elected thereto concurring:

THAT, WHEREAS, there is no further public use for the first alley north of Bluff Avenue and extending from Glen Avenue to Wyandotte Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained that said alley be and the same is hereby vacated and that the plat of said premises be amended and modified to that extent.

The Clerk of the Village is directed to certify a copy of this ordinance to the County Auditor, that vacation of the alley may show upon the recorded plat thereof.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
