CITY OF GRANDVIEW HEIGHTS, OHIO
AN ORDINANCE
NO. 57-52

To approve and acknowledge the Court's finding and orders declaring Avondale Avenue a Public Street.

Be It Enacted by the Council of the City of Grandview Heights, Ohio:

Section 1. There having been filed on June 23, 1952. an entry in the case of Schmertz vs Grandview Lumber Company, No. 172244, reciting the Court's finding that a certain strip of land known and described as Avondale Avenue to be a public street.

Section 2. That a copy of the entry is attached to this ordinance and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.

Section 3. In the case of Schmertz vs Crissman, et al, No. 172245, of the Court of Common Pleas, Franklin County and being a companion case to that mentioned in section 1 of this ordinance, the Court dismissed the action upon call of the cases no cause being shown why it should be retained.

Section 4. The Court having found that the described portion of Avondale Avenue is a public street by prescription and by dismissing the case that describes the west half of said street from the South line of Goodale Boulevard to the north line of the Pittsburgh, Cincinnati, Chicago, and St. Louis Railroad. The City of Grandview Heights by this ordinance hereby accepts and acknowledges that portion of Avondale Avenue found by the Court's actions to be a street by prescriptive right, and does hereby declare the same to be a public street within the City of Grandview Heights.

Section 5. This ordinance to take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law.
