ORDINANCE NO. 598

To narrow Bluff Avenue from an 80-foot width to a 50-foot width, beginning at a point where said street is now 50 feet wide to the west corporation line and thereby making said street 50 feet in width in its entirety

Whereas, on the 3rd day of September, 1930, a petition, by persons owning all the lots abutting on said street from a point where said street is now 50 feet in width to the west corporation line, was duly presented to Council, praying that said street, between the points named, be narrowed from an 80-foot width to a 50-foot width; and

Whereas, the written consent to the narrowing of said street by all abutting property owners thereon has been filed with the Council, and no publication is required by law; and

Whereas, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such narrowing of said street as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made;

Now, Therefore, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Grandview Heights, Ohio, three-fourths of all the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Bluff Avenue, from a point where it is now 50 feet wide to the west corporation line, be and the same is hereby narrowed from a width of 80 feet to a width of 50 feet, and a 15-foot strip on either side thereof is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
