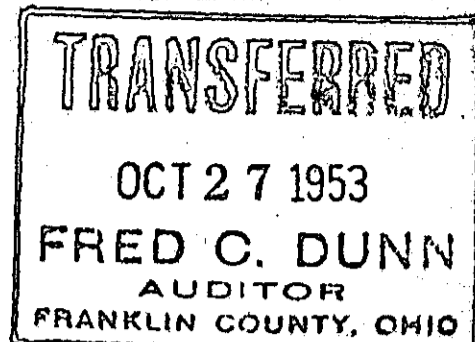

ORDINANCE NO. 320



An Ordinance to vacate Buel Alley from Cherry Street, south to its point of termination.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Groveport, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1. That whereas, on the 17th day of August, 1953, a petition of persons owning all property on both sides of Buel Alley, from Cherry Street to its south termination point, was duly presented to Council, praying that said Alley, between the points named, be vacated, and

Whereas, notice of such vacation is not required to be given, as written consent to such vacation has been given by all the owners of the property abutting that part of Buel Alley proposed to be vacated, and

Whereas, Council is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, ought to be made; therefore

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Groveport, Franklin County, Ohio

SECTION 1. That Buel Alley from Cherry Street to its termination point be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
