

ORDINANCE NO. 351 - 55

To vacate Cherry Street in the Village of Groveport, Ohio, between Tallman Street in R. D. Miller's Addition to Groveport, Ohio and Kessler's Addition to the Village of Groveport, Ohio, and reserving a five-foot easement therein over, under and upon five feet off of the southerly portion of said vacated street to the Village of Groveport, Ohio.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Groveport, Ohio that:

Whereas, a petition has been filed with Council praying for the vacation of Cherry Street between Tallman Street in R. D. Miller's Addition to Groveport, Ohio and Kessler's Addition to the Village of Groveport, Ohio, and whereas Council, upon hearing, has found that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and that there is good cause for such vacation, be it known, therefore, that:

Section 1. Cherry Street in the Village of Groveport, Ohio between Tallman Street in R. D. Miller's Addition to the Village of Groveport, Ohio and the westerly line of Kessler's Addition in said Village be and the same is hereby vacated, and there is hereby reserved to the Village of Groveport, Ohio an easement over five feet off of the south side of said vacated portion of Cherry Street for utility purposes, described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot No. 11 in R. D. Miller's Groveport Addition, as shown in Plat Book 22, p. 90, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio; thence North 5 feet; thence West (parallel to and five feet north of the north line of Lot No. 11 in said addition) 128 feet to the east line of Tallman Street; thence South 5 feet; thence East with the north line of Lot No. 11, 128 feet to the place of beginning.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
