ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

2. 40

An ordinance amendment to clarify Ordinance #2, namely, the following streets and public ways are hereby accepted and confirmed as thoroughfares in the Village of Riverlea.

Section #1: That all alleys running East and West between Olentangy Boulevard and the east corporation limits and the reserve at the end of Dover Court; all alleys running East and West between Dover Court and Beverly Place to corporation line and all alleys running East and West between Beverly Place and Southington Avenue, to corporation line; all alleys running North and South between Melbourne Place and Riverglen Drive; alleys running East and West and North and South between Olentangy, Southington, Falmouth and Riverglen Drive; all alleys running East and West from Olentangy and High Street on North edge of corporation limits; also the 20 feet at end of Falmouth Court, running North to corporation limits; the 50 feet at end of Pioneers Street running North to corporation limits; all alleys running East and West from Dover Court to Eastern edge of corporation limits; all alleys running North and South to respective corporation limits between High Street and Carrington Court; alleys running North and South and East and West between Crescent Court and Carrington Court and Southington Avenue and Riverglen Drive; alleys East and West and North and South between Carrington Court and Pioneers Street, Southington Avenue and Riverglen Drive; alleys North and South and East and West between Pioneers Street and Westchester Court and Southington Avenue and Riverglen Drive; alleys running East and West and North and South between Westchester Court and Falmouth Court and Southington Avenue and Riverglen Drive. The reserve at the South end of Pioneer Street, 50 feet wide and running South to corporation limits; all alleys and unpaved streets in the Village of Riverlea.

Section #2: All these alleys and streets were not accepted by the Village Council and are here again disclaimed and denied and vacated.

Section #3: That the Village of Riverlea reserves the right to operate and maintain any and all sewers, water lines and other public utilities

19 owned by said Village and that the right is reserved to operate and maintain any and all other public utilities if any now existing on or in said alley or street to be vacated and shall have the right to enter thereon for the purposes of operating, replacing and maintaining the same.

Section #4: That this said amendment shall take effect and shall be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
