ORDINANCE NO. 1000 - 48

TO VACATE AN UNNAMED, UNIMPROVED STREET  
RUNNING WESTERLY FROM UPPER CHELSEA ROAD  
AND TO VACATE AND ABANDON A SMALL PARK  
AT THE ENTRANCE OF SAID STREET, HEREIN  
DESCRIBED

WHEREAS, all of the owners of the property  
abutting the unimproved street and park at the entrance  
of said street, hereinafter described, have petitioned  
the Commission to vacate the same; and

WHEREAS, under Section 3727 of the General  
Code of Ohio, it is unnecessary to publish notice of said  
vacation since all of the abutting property owners have  
petitioned for said vacation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission is satisfied that there  
is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it  
will not be detrimental to the general interests and  
ought to be made;

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commission of the City  
of Upper Arlington, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the unimproved street running  
westerly from Upper Chelsea Road and the park at the  
entrance of said street, described as follows:




That part of West Devon Road and Chelsea Road, including the park area, which is more than 50 feet westerly from the east property line of Chelsea Road lying between Stanford Road and the intersection of Chelsea Road and Lower Chelsea Road; at no place within the limits of Chelsea Road herein described shall the minimum width of Chelsea Road be reduced below 50 feet 0 inches; in other words the revised westerly line of Chelsea Road shall be no less than 50 feet radially from the east property line thereof.

**be and the same is hereby vacated.**

**Section 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.**
